

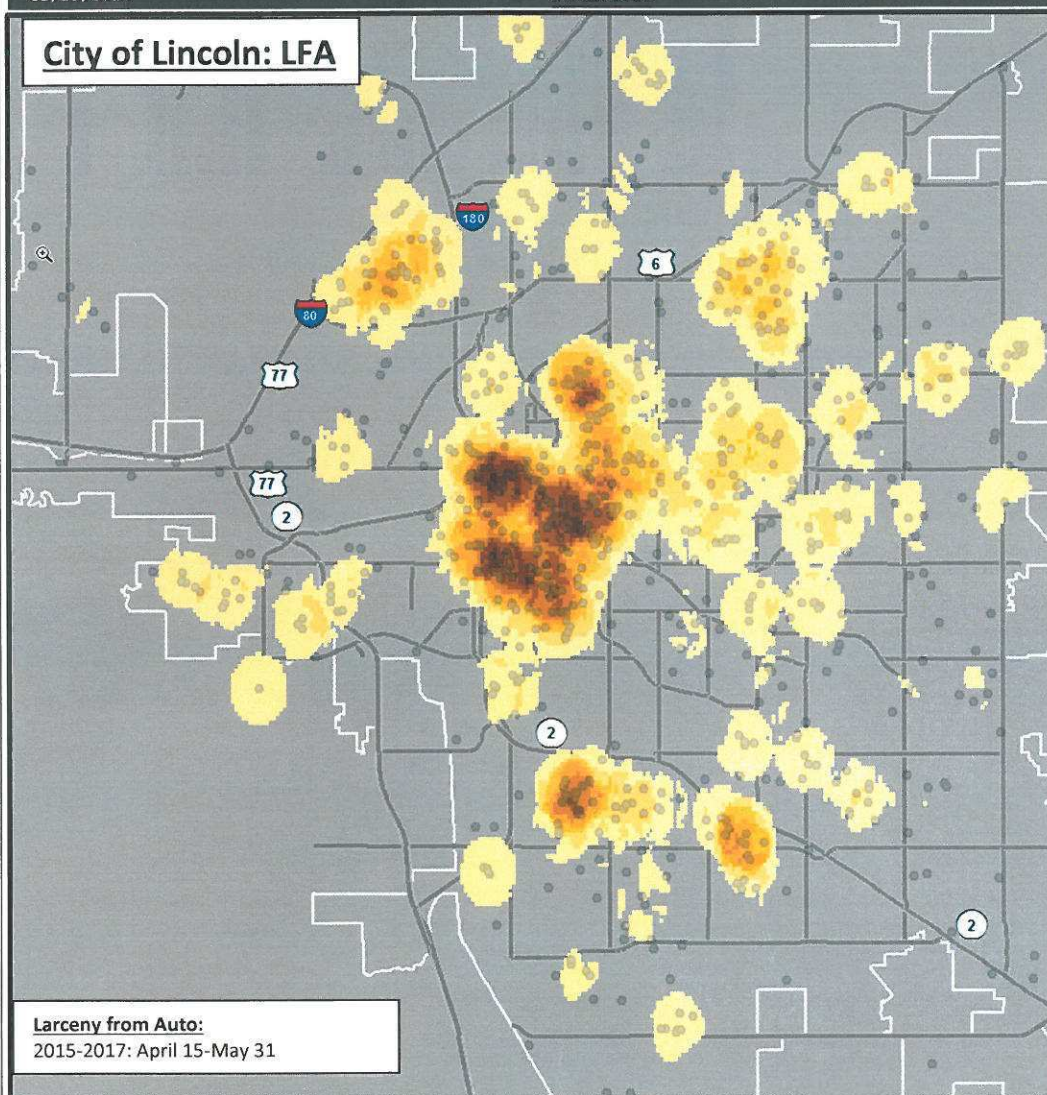
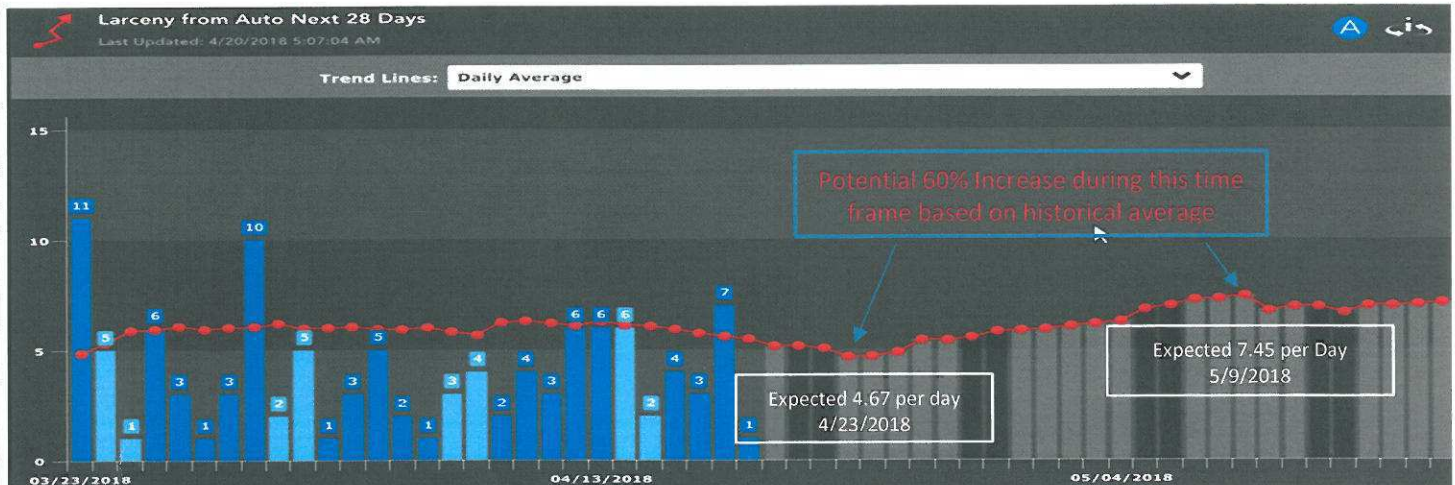


## LINCOLN POLICE DEPARTMENT CRIME ANALYSIS UNIT

Subject: Larceny from Auto's: Spring 2018

Over the next two to three weeks, Lincoln can anticipate an increase in Larceny's from Auto (LFA). Based on historical data, LPD will take an average of 4.6 Calls for Service (CFS) for LFA during this next week with a steady increase until the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of May in which LPD may average 7.49 CFS. The map and notes below indicate potential hot spots of LFA from 2015-2017 from April 15 to May 31.



### Notes: April 15 to May 31 during the year 2015-2017

- More LFA's were reported Monday morning from 5AM to 9 AM than any other day.
- Sunday was the lowest day of the week victims reported the LFA's to LPD.
- Victims report Sunday as being the highest day of the week in which the LFA's may have actually occurred.
- 61.4% of victims reported leaving the vehicle unlocked resulting in \$202,490 in losses.
- More than 60 victims reported at least \$1000 in losses.
- 20 victims in which the LFA was a listed as a broken glass or smash/grab reported at least \$500 in losses.
