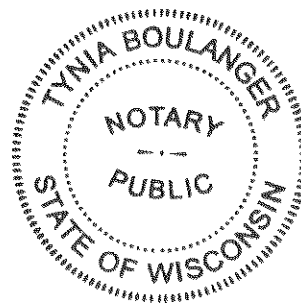

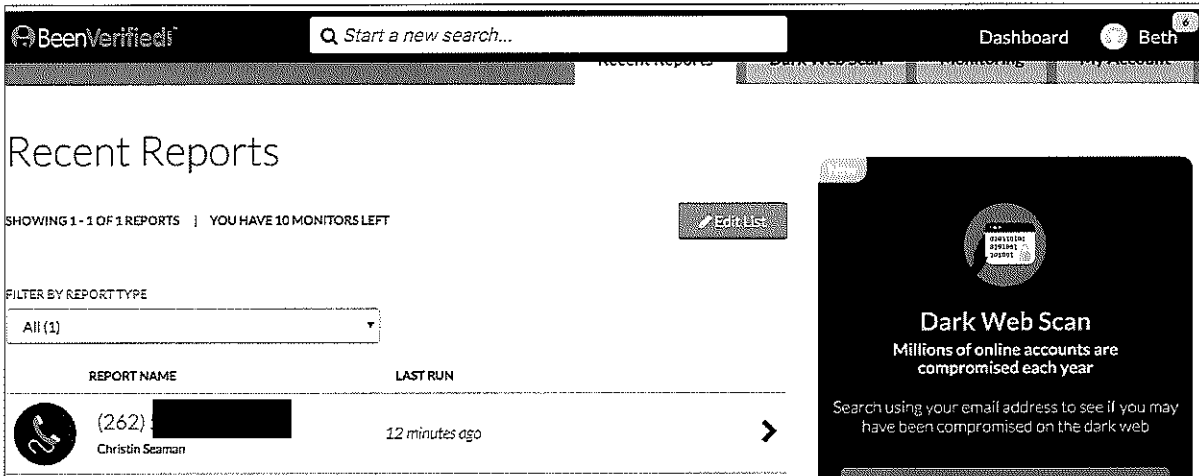

I am filing this complaint as a resident of the City of Racine's 13<sup>th</sup> Aldermanic District. I personally verify that all information contained within this complaint is factual and true. While I realize this complaint may cause me harm, as Respondent has a long, documented history of filing false charges against people who she believes have wronged her, the multiple campaign finance and ethics violations are clear enough to demand an investigation and response from the Wisconsin Ethics Commission and the Racine County District Attorney.

Evidence of these multiple violations includes text messages sent to me and at least one other 13<sup>th</sup> District resident by the Respondent using the pseudonym "Breanna" from phone number (262) [REDACTED] screenshots of Respondent's various Facebook pages and profiles, and images taken of the Respondent's campaign materials. Initially, I believed "Breanna" to be a real person, however upon further investigation, including a reverse search of the phone number through the website <https://www.beenverified.com> on 2/15/2019, I can confirm Respondent is the likely owner of the phone number, that all messages were sent by Respondent, using a pseudonym to conceal her true identity and commit multiple violations.

## BACKGROUND

On Saturday, February 2, at 9:55 a.m., I received an unsolicited text message from Respondent using the pseudonym "Breanna" from phone number (262) [REDACTED] explicitly seeking my support and my vote for Respondent Christina Seaman, a candidate running for an open seat in the City of Racine's 13<sup>th</sup> Aldermanic District. I am not the only voter in the City of Racine's 13<sup>th</sup> District to receive this unsolicited text message from "Breanna". When I inquired as to who the sender was, "Breanna" responded that she "was given a list of voters in Racine" and was "contacting them about the upcoming election." Upon further inquiry, "Breanna" informed me that she had my full name, address, phone number, email address and that I voted in the Spring 2018 election via absentee ballot. All of this information about me is accurate.

“Breanna” then disclosed that she paid for this list, but that “we went half on the list price with someone else who is running.” While she did not specify who “we” is, it certainly seemed that she was referring to herself and Respondent. At this point, I began to feel that “Breanna” was not who she claimed to be, and concerns over the veracity and ethics of her claims began to raise red flags.

“Breanna” claimed that Respondent was completely unaware of “Breanna’s” actions, and that “Breanna” and friends “found a way to help out”, even though Respondent isn’t raising money. Some of “Breanna’s” help includes paying for lists of voter information (totaling \$3,000, which she falsely claims she split the cost of with the two other people running in the primary), yard signs (\$500 for 100) and professionally printed campaign flyers (\$1 each).

While “Breanna” maintains Respondent is unaware of her actions, this is demonstrably false, even beyond knowing that Respondent is the likely owner of the phone number being used. Respondent has several incidents of using materials provided by “Breanna”, including the voter lists, yard signs, and campaign flyers.

On Tuesday, January 20, 2019 at 9:15 a.m., I received an unsolicited Facebook message to my private, personal Facebook account from Respondent, using her own name. In this message, Respondent stated that she is “running to be my Alderwoman in district 13.” (emphasis mine) Nowhere in my Facebook profile does it state my address or in which Aldermanic District I live. As I am not friends on Facebook or offline with Respondent, she would have no way of knowing who I am or if I reside in the 13<sup>th</sup> District. Respondent received this information from the voter list paid for and provided by “Breanna”.

Additionally, both Respondent’s latest batch of yard signs (paid for by “Breanna”) and the original batch of yards signs share the same colors, design, type and disclaimer “Paid for by Friends of Christina Seaman”, and Respondent has shared multiple images of her yard signs on her personal and campaign Facebook pages. Claiming that the Respondent is “unaware” that she is using signs bought and paid for by someone else is ridiculous, at best, and a gross violation of campaign finance laws at worst. To further compound this violation, Respondent has also been using the professionally printed campaign flyers, which clearly are written in a first-person voice, using the same slogans and images as Respondent’s other campaign materials.

### **VIOLATION 1: False Representations Affecting Elections**

**Statute:** § 12.05. “False representations affecting elections. No person may knowingly make or publish, or cause to be made or published, a false representation pertaining to a candidate or referendum which is intended or tends to affect voting at an election.”

Respondent not only falsely claimed to be another elector, “Breanna”, for the purposes of influencing a vote, Respondent also made false claims against her opponents. One of the more egregious claims Respondent made was against Natalie Taft, in claiming that Natalia paid “Breanna” for the walk list. This is demonstrably false, as Natalia received her own, separate, and far-superior voter list as an in-kind contribution. She would have no need to purchase a different, lower-quality voter list. Respondent maintained her false identity as “Breanna” for several days in early February.

Violations of this statute carry with it a monetary fine of not more than \$1,000, or imprisonment of not more than six months, or both. (§ 12.60(1)b.)

### **VIOLATION 2: Campaign Finance Individual Limits**

**Statute:** § 11.1101(1)(h)1. “Candidates for local offices, an amount equal to the greater of the following:

1. Five hundred dollars.
2. Two cents times the number of inhabitants of the jurisdiction or district, according to the latest federal census or the census information on which the district is based, as certified by the appropriate filing officer, but not more than \$6,000.”

For the City of Racine Aldermanic District 13, which has a population of under 25,000, the maximum individual campaign contribution limit is \$500.

All contributions, including in-kind contributions, are subject to this limit. The contributions from “Breanna” total at least \$3,501, which is at least seven times the legal limit for an individual contribution, including in-kind contributions.

### **VIOLATION 3: Campaign Finance “Fair Market Value” Limits**

**Statute:** § 11.1105(1). “Except as provided in § 11.1111, for purposes of complying with a contribution limit under this section, the value of a contribution of any tangible or intangible item, other than money, is the item's fair market value at the time that the individual or committee made the contribution.”

In this case, the “fair market value” of the items purchased by “Breana” and provided to Respondent total at least \$3,501.

### **VIOLATION 4: Filing a False Campaign Finance Registration Statement (CF-1) (1/2)**

**Statute:** § 11.0202(1). “Registration; timing; candidate committee required.

(1) Time of registration.

(a) Each candidate, through his or her candidate committee, shall file a registration statement with the appropriate filing officer giving the information required under s. 11.0203 as soon as practicable after the individual qualifies as a candidate under s. 11.0101 (1).

(b) A candidate who receives no contributions, makes no disbursements, and incurs no obligations shall file the registration statement as provided in this subsection, but need not designate

a campaign depository account until the first contribution is received, disbursement is made, or obligation is incurred.”

Respondent filed her Campaign Finance Registration Statement (CF-1) as “Exempt”, and included a personal note, in Respondent’s handwriting and signed by Respondent, that stated “I am not spending or receiving any funds for my race for Alderman in the 13<sup>th</sup> District.” This is a false statement, as Respondent clearly has received and/or spent at least \$3,501 in her race for Alderman in the 13<sup>th</sup> District, well over the \$2,000 limit for campaigns to be considered “Exempt”. Respondent declared this on her Campaign Finance Registration Statement (CF-1), received 1/2/2019 by the City of Racine City Clerk. No amended Campaign Finance Registration Statement (CF-1) is on file with the City of Racine City Clerk.

**VIOLATION 5: Filing a False Campaign Finance Registration Statement (CF-1) (2/2)**

**Statute:** § 11.0202(2)a. Registration; timing; candidate committee required.

“(2) CANDIDATE COMMITTEE REQUIRED.

(a) Except as provided in par. (b), no candidate may make or accept contributions, make disbursements, or incur obligations except through a candidate committee registered under this subchapter.

(b) A candidate does not violate this subsection by taking any of the following actions:

1. Accepting a contribution, making a disbursement, or incurring an obligation in the amount required to rent a postal box, or in the minimum amount required by a bank or trust company to open a checking account, prior to the time of registration, if the disbursement is properly reported on the first report submitted under s. 11.0204 after the date that the candidate committee is registered, whenever a reporting requirement applies to the candidate committee.

2. Accepting a contribution, making a disbursement, or incurring an obligation required for the production of nomination papers.

(c) Except as provided in par. (d), no candidate may establish more than one candidate committee.”

Respondent, by using materials paid for and provided by “Breanna”, is in violation of this statute as Respondent did not declare “Friends of Christina Seaman” as her candidate committee on her Campaign Finance Registration Statement (CF-1), received 1/2/2019 by the City of Racine City Clerk. No amended Campaign Finance Registration Statement (CF-1) is on file with the City of Racine City Clerk.

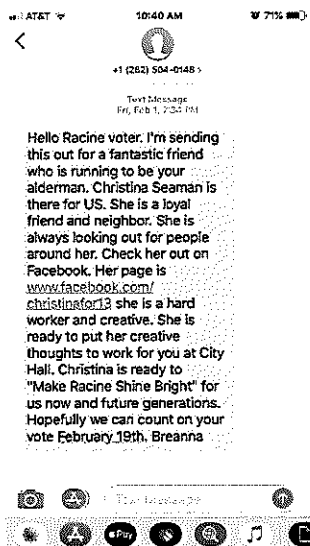


