Dear WGSD families,

As mandated by law, the role of WGSD is to report any allegation or suspicion of abuse to law enforcement. These reports are confidential and serious. On March 18, 2022, such a report came to our attention at Woodfield Elementary and we reported this to the Racine County Sheriff's Department and Racine County Child Protective Services. Racine County has investigated the situation. All families that were involved have been interviewed by law enforcement. No employees of WGSD, Waterford Area School-age Program(WASP), or any adults were involved and no charges were filed.

We would like to reassure you that your children are safe and have been. In the future, we will continue to work with law enforcement to ensure that we maintain safety and respect the confidentiality of the people involved in allegations.

We will continue to keep you informed if there is a safety concern for your children.
