Subject: Ethics Complaint regard Mayor Lily Wu and Wichita Ordinance, Title 2. Administration and Personnel, Chapter 2.04 City Council, Section 2.04.100.

Dear Member of the Ethics Board,

This ethics complaint is made on behalf of the IAFF Local 135 membership/bargaining unit as a whole, as well as the citizens of the Wichita community.

I. Factual Background.

During a meeting with Chief Snow, the IAFF Local 135 President, Ted Bush, was informed by Chief Snow that Mayor Lily Wu came to her individually, and outside of any public City Council meeting or actions and informed her that Chief Snow must lay off forty-five (45) employees within the Wichita Fire Department before the end of 2025, and that she did not have any choice in the matter.

The Fire Chief communicated to President Bush that the meeting was solely at the discretion of Mayor Wu. President Bush was not informed if this was a scheduled meeting or just showed up in her office for this impromptu communication, where the Mayor informed her, again completely by herself and purporting to be able to make these orders based solely upon her authority as Mayor, that she must slash her department personnel by forty-five (45) employees – even though the recent Levrum study, procured by the City of Wichita, indicated that department is over one hundred (100) members short at the current level.

As communicated by Chief Snow, Mayor Wu visited her office and informed her of the above and told her she did not care how she did, but that she must reduce personnel by the forty-five (45) positions. Chief Snow agreed to enact the layoffs but did advise her of the extreme negative impact it would have on the Wichita Fire Department and the City of Wichita.

Pursuant to Wichita Ordinance Title 2. Administration and personnel, Chapter 2.04 – City Counsel, section 2.04.100, which strictly prohibits such communications and instructions by individual members of the Council. Specifically, the ordinance states:

"No instructions or directions shall be given by individual council members to department heads or to other city employees who shall refer such instructions immediately to the city manager, who, in turn, shall bring such improper actions to the attention of the entire council for such action as may be appropriate in each individual case." (Ord. No. 47-858, section 17, 3-28-08).

The communication by Mayor Wu to Chief Snow clearly violated the ordinance above, attempted to inflict undue influence and/or coercion by a single member of City Council over a Department Head, and more specifically over how the Department Head is running her department, which is strictly prohibited by the ordinance is improper and unethical.

- 2. Resolution of this complaint shall include the following:
 - Complete investigation into the actions of the Mayor in trying to individually induce, influence, or coerce Department Heads control and administration of their departments outside of the City Council as a whole.
 - Retraction of any instructions or actions by Mayor Wu to Chief Snow until proper procedures, meetings, and investigations are completed.
 - Due to the massive impact on the Wichita Fire Department by the improper request, the Union requests that prior to any terminations of employment of any unit members, that the City is required to meet and confer in good faith, as such matters are mandatory subjects of negotiation as dictated by PEERA.
 - Letter of apology to Chief Snow and the Union from Mayor Wu for the inappropriate manner in which her instructions to fire forty-five (45) Wichita Fire Department personnel at her own solitary instruction were made to the Wichita Fire Department head.
 - Immediate discontinuance of any inappropriate direct and singular communications by Mayor
 Wu to individual department heads or Wichita employees.
 - Assurance and promise from the City of Wichita that they will not make further cuts to Fire
 Department personnel that will place Wichita Firefighters and the Wichita Community at an
 extreme risk of harm to property, health, and life.
