ORDER GRANTING DIVERSION

NOW, on this 23rd day of January, 2025, the State of Kansas, by and through its attorney, Robert Short, Assistant District Attorney; and the Defendant, Meghan Blubaugh, appear and jointly move the Court to place the above entitled case on the Deferred Prosecution Docket.

Being fully advised in the premises, the Court finds that an Agreement for Diversion, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", was executed by the parties in which the State of Kansas agreed to defer prosecution of the offense charged in the Complaint/Information for a period of six (6) months from the date of the Agreement. The defendant voluntarily consented to such deferred prosecution and waived any defense to prosecution on the ground that a speedy trial has been denied, and the defendant has waived her rights to a trial by jury and has agreed to be tried on stipulated facts, should a trial become necessary.

The Court further finds all sureties are relieved of liability on any bond to insure the appearance of this defendant. The defendant, as principle, is not relieved of liability on any appearance bond.

The Court finds that in addition to other costs owed, the following amounts are due to the Clerk of the District Court in accordance with the Diversion Agreement:

1. \$160.00 Court Costs, due during the course of diversion, in accordance with the diversion agreement.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this matter be stricken from the Court's trial docket and placed on the Deferred Prosecution Docket until further order.
