- Eligible **course titles and descriptions**, by category; now available
 - e.g. American Literature for English; Life Science for Science
- Comprehensive work-based learning guidance, including a **landscape analysis**; *coming soon*
 - Current Graduation Pathways Guidance
- Market-driven **credential of value** list; now available
- **Interactive advising tool** to support local implementation; exploring a market-driven solution
 - Will engage parents, students, principals, and school counselors to design a tool that increases transparency around pathway options and helps map progress
- Increased flexibility on **who can teach high school and college courses**; in progress
- Rulemaking on **new accountability model** aligned to diplomas; in progress

IMPLEMENTATION RESOURCES & SUPPORTS CONT.

- New **public service course** for those pursuing the enlistment and service seal; now available
 - Schools can also request mentors from the Indiana National Guard to help in implementing the enlistment and service seal.
- **Transportation and Facilities Pilot Opportunity**; announced in October 2025
- **Career Scholarship Accounts** – provide \$5,000 annually to high school students, which can be used for work-based learning (WBL) opportunities, such as apprenticeships, internships, and more
- **Incentives for Schools**
 - Schools will receive funding ranging from \$500 to \$2,500 for credentials of value.
 - Schools will also receive additional funding for each student who earns a readiness seal.
