- Market-driven credential of value list; now available
- Interactive advising tool to support local implementation; exploring a market-driven solution
  - Will engage parents, students, principals, and school counselors to design a tool that increases transparency around pathway options and helps map progress
- Increased flexibility on who can teach high school and college courses; in progress
- Rulemaking on new accountability model aligned to diplomas; in progress



## IMPLEMENTATION RESOURCES & SUPPORTS CONT.

- New **public service course** for those pursuing the enlistment and service seal; <u>now available</u>
  - Schools can also request mentors from the Indiana National Guard to help in implementing the enlistment and service seal.
- **Transportation and Facilities** Pilot Opportunity; <u>announced in October 2025</u>
- **Career Scholarship Accounts** provide \$5,000 annually to high school students, which can be used for work-based learning (WBL) opportunities, such as apprenticeships, internships, and more
- Incentives for Schools
  - Schools will receive funding ranging from \$500 to \$2,500 for credentials of value.
  - Schools will also receive additional funding for each student who earns a readiness seal.
