I, Melissa G Handke, the undersigned District Attorney of said County, in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, give information that in said County of Murray and in the State of Oklahoma, CALVIN WESLEY HILLIARD did then and there unlawfully, willfully, knowingly and wrongfully commit the crime(s) of:

COUNT I: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ a FELONY, on or between the 23rd day of July, 2024 and the 24th day of December, 2024, by fraudulently appropriating the sum of \$15,450.00 (an \$8,000 debit; \$2,250.00 from check number a \$3,000 debit; and a \$2,200 debit) that belonged to Murray County Jr. Livestock Auction which had been entrusted to the said defendant by Murray County Jr. Livestock Auction.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for up to 8 years and a fine not to exceed \$10,000 and restitution.

COUNT II: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 16th day of January, 2024, by fraudulently appropriating the sum of \$2,500.00 from check number from account number that belonged to Murray County Jr. Livestock Association's Premium Fund which had been entrusted to the said defendant by Murray County Jr. Livestock Association.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for up to 5 years and a fine not to exceed \$5,000 and restitution.

COUNT III: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 17th day of January, 2024, by fraudulently appropriating the sum of \$3,000.00 from check number from account number that belonged to Murray County Jr. Livestock Association's Premium Fund which had been entrusted to the said defendant by Murray County Jr. Livestock Association.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for up to 5 years and a fine not to exceed \$5,000 and restitution.

COUNT IV: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 14th day of March, 2024, by fraudulently appropriating the sum of \$2,875.00 from check number from account number that belonged to Murray Couty Jr. Livestock Association's Premium Fund which had been entrusted to the said defendant by Murray Couty Jr. Livestock Association.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for up to 5 years and a fine not to exceed \$5,000 and restitution.

- COUNT V: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 11th day of December, 2024, by fraudulently appropriating the sum of \$3,500.00 from check number that belonged to Murray County Jr. Livestock Association and had been entrusted to the said defendant by Murray County Jr. Livestock Association.
- This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for up to 5 years and a fine not to exceed \$5,000 and restitution.
- COUNT VI: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 15th day of May, 2024, by fraudulently appropriating the sum of \$3,000.00 in cash that belonged to Murray County Jr. Livestock Association's Premium Fund and had been entrusted to the said defendant by Murray County Jr. Livestock Association.
- This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for up to 5 years and a fine not to exceed \$5,000 and restitution.
- COUNT VII: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 10th day of June, 2024, by fraudulently appropriating the sum of \$1,257.31 from check number that belonged to Murray County Jr. Livestock Association and had been entrusted to the said defendant by Murray County Jr. Livestock Association.
- This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term of not more than two (2) years, or in the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, by a fine not to exceed \$5,000.00, or by both such fine and imprisonment and restitution.
- COUNT VIII: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 5th day of December, 2024, by fraudulently appropriating the sum of \$1,150.00 from check number that belonged to Murray County Jr. Livestock Association and had been entrusted to the said defendant by Murray County Jr. Livestock Association.
- This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term of not more than two (2) years, or in the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, by a fine not to exceed \$5,000.00, or by both such fine and imprisonment and restitution.
- COUNT IX: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 24th day of May, 2024, by fraudulently appropriating the sum of \$1,000.00 in cash from account number that belonged to Murray County Jr. Livestock Association's Premium Fund and had been entrusted to the said defendant by Murray County Jr. Livestock Association.
- This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term of not more than two (2) years, or in the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, by a fine not to exceed \$5,000.00, or by both such fine and imprisonment and restitution.
- COUNT X: EMBEZZLEMENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 4th day of June, 2024, by fraudulently appropriating the sum of \$1,500.00 in cash that belonged to Murray County Jr. Livestock Association's Premium Fund and had been entrusted to the said defendant by Murray County Jr. Livestock Association.
- This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term of not more than two (2) years, or in the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, by a fine not to exceed \$5,000.00, or by both such fine and imprisonment and restitution.
- COUNT XI: UTTERING FORGED INSTRUMENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 6th day of December, 2024, by uttering or publishing as true, \$3,180 from check number on the account of the Murray County Jr. Livestock Association and made payable to Wes Hilliard, said check bearing the signature of which was not the true and correct signature of and of which was deposited into the defendant's personal banking account, and done with the intent to cheat and defraud and knowing that the check was forged, altered, and or counterfeit.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term of not more than five (5) years, or in the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, by a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

- COUNT XII: UTTERING FORGED INSTRUMENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 11th day of December, 2024, by uttering or publishing as true, \$2,750 from check number on the account of the Murray County Jr. Livestock Association and made payable to Wes Hilliard, said check bearing the signature of in, which was not the true and correct signature of and of which was deposited into the defendant's personal banking account, and done with the intent to cheat and defraud and knowing that the check was forged, altered, and or counterfeit.
- This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term of not more than five (5) years, or in the county jail for a term not to exceed one (1) year, by a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

COUNT IX: PATTERN OF CRIMINAL OFFENSES IN TWO OR MORE COUNTIES ~ a FELONY, on or between the 24th day of December, 2024 and the 30th day of January, 2025, did knowingly use a debit card from Vision Bank on the account of the Murray County Jr. Livestock Association to make purchases for goods/services in Murray County and Garvin County, which were appropriated for his own use.

This crime is punishable by a fine of up to \$25,000 and/or imprisonment for up to 2 years.
