I stand alongside numerous precinct chairs in the Tarrant County Republican Party, disturbed by Chairman French's consistent disparaging remarks of women, public berating of those in the gay community, and recent outright vile and dehumanizing language of those with special needs. The constant disturbing social media posts and public comments authored by Mr. French are not reflective of the values of the Republican Party. Nor is the ignorant, juvenile behavior repeatedly displayed by Mr. French conducive to the pertinent role and privilege of one serving as County Chairman.

Mr. French's counterproductive and outright destructive rhetoric is a detriment to the Tarrant County GOP. As a homeschooling mother of a child with unique needs, wife, former educator, and pro-life advocate, I call on Mr. French to publicly apologize for his repugnant comments. I am further calling on Mr. French to resign from his role as Chairman of the Tarrant County Republican Party effective immediately following the November elections.

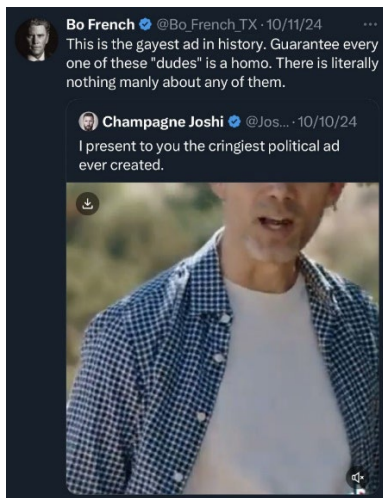
Conservative members, supporters, and constituents of Tarrant County GOP deserve a new, humble, respectful, and productive leader – one who is capable of being a decent human being laser-focused on improving the county party, draw new members and voters to the party, and promote the conservative movement rather than hindering it.

Below are just a few examples of recent Twitter/X activity I am referring to of the type of public social media posts that are not acceptable by our county party chair. His actions are “sufficiently egregious” and clear misconduct while in office. As such, according to the rules established by the Republican Party of Texas, the call for Bo French's resignation is valid as outlined in Rule 8, Section N, #5, as seen below.

- n. Elected Party Officials' Misconduct in Office – A Precinct Chair, County Chairman, or SREC member may be deemed to be derelict in the execution of his or her responsibilities in office, by:
1. Failing to perform statutory duties; or
 2. Failing to attend two (2) consecutive statutory Executive Committee Meetings; or
 3. Embezzling County Executive Committee funds; or
 4. Being convicted of election fraud; or
 5. At least three other documented instances of sufficiently egregious conduct that the Republican Party in that county or Senatorial District is subjected to public disgrace.
- The Elected Party Official being reviewed must be notified at least seven (7) days in advance of any meeting concerning his or her sanction and must be offered the opportunity to present his or her own defense before a vote on sanction is taken.
- Regarding a Precinct or County Chairman, a written complaint signed by at least sixty percent (60%) of the voting membership of the County Executive Committee, or regarding an SREC member, a written complaint signed by at least sixty percent (60%) of the voting membership of the District Executive Committee, shall be forwarded to the Officials Committee of the SREC. If the Officials Committee finds the complaint has merit, the Officials Committee shall conduct a hearing on the conduct of the Precinct or County Chairman, or SREC member, and shall forward a recommendation to the State Chairman to pursue appropriate remedy.
