Dear Parents and Guardians,

The School District of Onalaska was recently notified by the La Crosse County Health Department that a household member of a kindergarten student at Eagle Bluff Elementary has tested positive for COVID-19. Based on the information we were given, the risk of exposure for the student in the household was deemed to be low. The individual is following CDC guidelines and is monitoring his/her health in self isolation. The District is coordinating closely with public health officials and following CDC, state, and local health guidance in order to assure the health and safety of our community.

During the school closure, we ask that you continue to stay home, practice social distancing and follow the CDC recommendations for reducing the spread of COVID-19.

After receiving the news from the La Crosse County Health Department, the district made a decision to immediately restrict access to all district facilities. If you were not able to pick up your student's belongings today, please leave a message on the school's main number and we will coordinate pickup at a future date. We will continue to do everything we can to support our students, families, and staff through this difficult time.
