On 4/28/19, while working extra duty employment at the Flora-Bama Lounge and Package, I was notified of a fight inside. Upon arrival, I made contact with the victim, identified as [REDACTED], who was bleeding from the nose. [REDACTED] stated under oath that he had seen a man he knew to be the mayor of Orange Beach, Alabama, punching a wall by the mayor's wife's, identified as W/Paula Kennon, head. [REDACTED] stated when he stood up for W/Paula Kennon, S/Anthony Kennon hit him in the nose and an individual broke them up; at which time, they were broken up by security and escorted out of the building.

I then made contact with S/Anthony Kennon, who stated he and his wife, W/Paula Kennon, were having a verbal argument when [REDACTED] approached him and began screaming "Hey mayor, hey mayor!" S/Anthony Kennon stated he told [REDACTED] to leave him alone; at which time, [REDACTED] attempted to step into his face. S/Anthony Kennon stated he pushed [REDACTED] upper torso in self defense because he believed [REDACTED] was attempting to start a fight. S/Anthony Kennon stated he did not punch [REDACTED], but his hand may have accidentally deflected attempting to push [REDACTED] and may have accidentally gone towards his face.

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I then made contact with W/Paula Kennon, who stated her and her husband, S/Anthony Kennon, were having a verbal argument when [REDACTED] approached him stating "Hey mayor, hey mayor." W/Paula Kennon stated S/Anthony Kennon told [REDACTED] to leave; at which time, [REDACTED] approached S/Anthony Kennon again and she observed S/Anthony Kennon push [REDACTED] backwards in self defense.

Due to all parties being intoxicated and no independent witness that observed the entire incident, no arrest was made and all parties were removed from the premises and sent in separate directions.

[REDACTED] was provided a business card containing the case number as well as a Victim's Constitutional Rights Brochure.

There is no known video evidence of this incident.

On 5/3/2019, I received copies of in car and officer body camera footage, audio recordings and statements from Orange Beach Police Officers that responded, after the fact, to this incident.

I reviewed an in car video which documents a courtesy ride for S/Anthony Kennon and W/Paula Kennon, both of whom were transported to their residence. S/Kennon is not visible during the ride and the in car audio captures nothing of evidentiary nature.

The officer body camera footage documents the Orange Beach Police Officers responding to [REDACTED] location in Orange Beach and taking a report about the incident. Their investigation did not produce any independent witnesses to collaborate or disprove [REDACTED] account of events. [REDACTED] does make statements to the large amount of alcohol he consumed that day. Officers' Incident Statements are consistent with the body camera footage.

A review of the provided information from the Orange Beach Police Department provides no new additional information. Based on no new information of substance, independent witnesses or video collaboration, I recommend this case be closed. No further police action taken.

Copies of the Orange Beach Police Department reports and video will be submitted into evidence.
