NON-PARTISAN**CONSTITUTIONAL
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

*Proposed by Article IV, Section 47(c)
(Second Regular Session) SJR No. 1*

Shall Missouri continue for 10 years the one-tenth of one percent sales/use tax that is used for soil and water conservation and for state parks and historic sites, and resubmit this tax to the voters for approval in 10 years?

The measure allows continued collection of the existing sales and use tax, which generates revenue of approximately \$140 million annually.

**CONSTITUTIONAL
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

*Proposed by 103rd General Assembly,
(First Regular Session) HCS HJR
Nos. 23 & 3*

Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to:

- require all charter counties, including Jackson County, to provide for the election of a county assessor; and
- require assessors in all charter counties to comply with any training requirements established by general law?

AMENDMENT NO. 4**

*Proposed by 103rd General Assembly
(Second Extraordinary Session) HCS
HJR No. 3*

Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to:

- Modify current requirements that a statewide majority of voters may approve initiative petitions to amend the constitution;
- Require a majority of voters in each congressional district to approve initiative petitions to amend the constitution; and
- Make available to each voter the full text of initiative petitions with their ballot?

The Department of Corrections estimates increased annual costs of up to \$21,817. The Office of State Public Defender estimates an unknown fiscal impact. Other state governmental entities estimate no costs or savings. Local governmental entities estimate no costs or savings.

**CONSTITUTIONAL
AMENDMENT NO. 5**

*Proposed by 103rd General Assembly,
(Second Regular Session) SS SCS
HCS HJR Nos. 173 & 174*

Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to:

- Require legislative phase-out of the individual state income tax based on revenue growth, and authorize the expansion of sales and use taxes;
- Curtail constitutional limits on taxing goods and services; and
- Require local tax rate cuts without reducing school funding if local sales tax revenue increases?

The proposal has no direct impact on state or local tax revenue. If passed, implementing legislation will have an unknown impact to state and local tax revenue. If implemented, state government entities expect a reduction of \$57,000 annually in income tax check-off donations and implementation costs of at least \$100,000.

SMITHTON R-VI SCHOOL DISTRICT

PROPOSITION T.I.G.E.R.

Shall the Board of Education of the Smithton R-VI School District,, Missouri, borrow money in the amount of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds to implement safety and security improvements District-wide; to renovate the existing Elementary school drop off area and relocate the entrance and offices spaces in the Elementary school; to renovate and update the playground space; to resurface and expand parking on the East side of the campus; to relocate and renovate the preschool; to provide covered areas at the entrance of the elementary and secondary buildings; to convert existing lighting, to LED; to renovate ceilings, floors, and walls in classrooms; to replace heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) units; to upgrade sidewalks to install new turf and landscaping; to the extent funds are available, acquire equipment and complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof resulting in an estimated increase to the debt service property tax levy of \$0.4500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to increase from \$0.0000 to \$0.4500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
