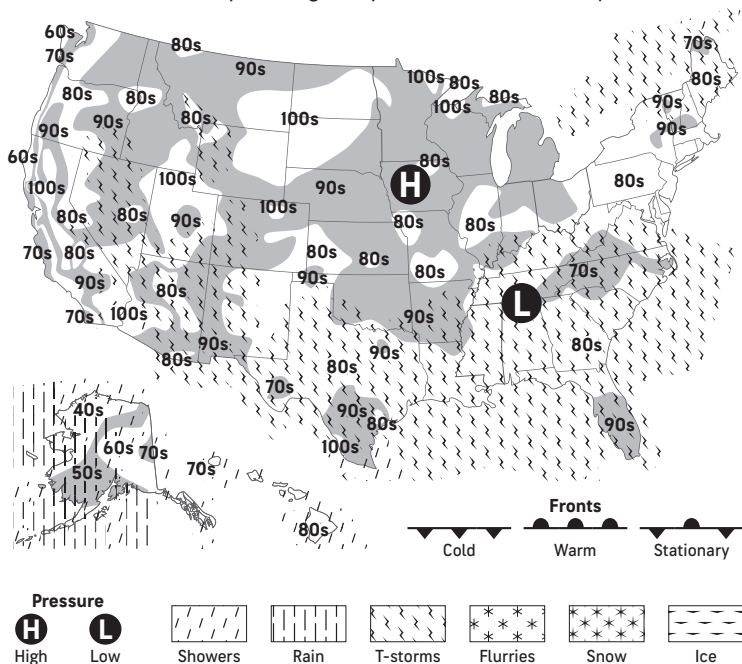


Forecast for Monday, July 13, 2026

NATIONAL SUMMARY: A potent heat dome will spread temperatures 5-15 degrees above average from the Pacific Northwest through the Midwest and into the Great Lakes today. Much warmer air will begin to spill into the Northeast. It will be humid across the southern third of the nation as drenching thunderstorms occur. There could be flash flooding in any downpour.
