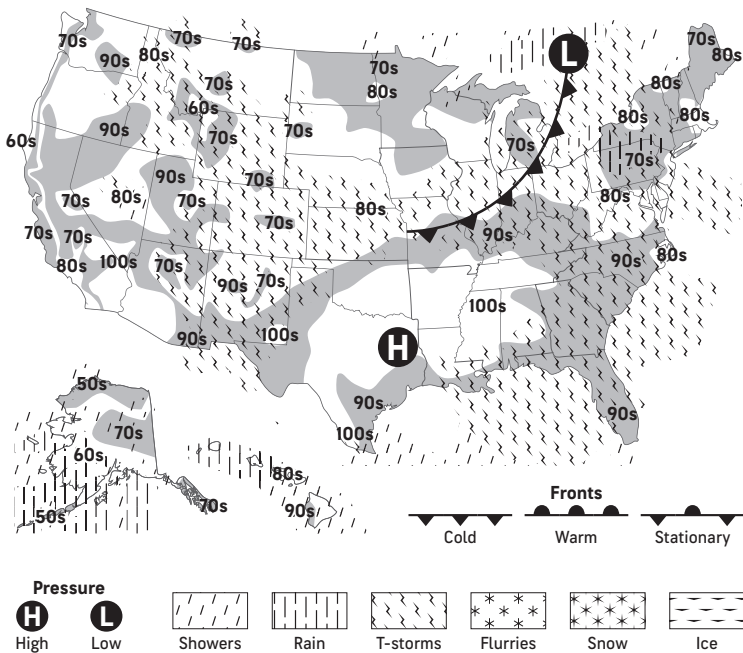


Forecast for Sunday, August 16, 2026

NATIONAL SUMMARY: Drenching thunderstorms will spread across the Great Lakes and mid-Atlantic tomorrow, bringing a risk of flash flooding and damaging wind gusts. Spotty storms will also spread into the Southeast. As heat grips southern parts of the Plains, storms will dot much of the Rockies. Meanwhile, the West Coast will remain dry and partly sunny.

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
