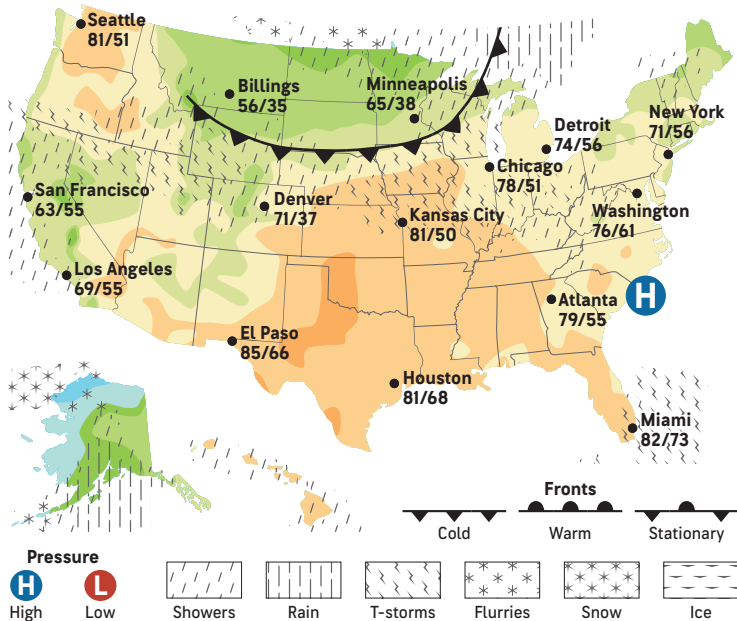


Forecast for Monday, May 4, 2026

NATIONAL SUMMARY: A little rain will linger in South Florida, but the rest of the Southeast will be dry today. Spotty showers will dot an area from California to Nebraska, particularly in the afternoon. Late in the day, thunderstorms sparking across the Midwest and Ohio Valley may bring damaging winds and hail. Warmth will expand into the Northeast.
