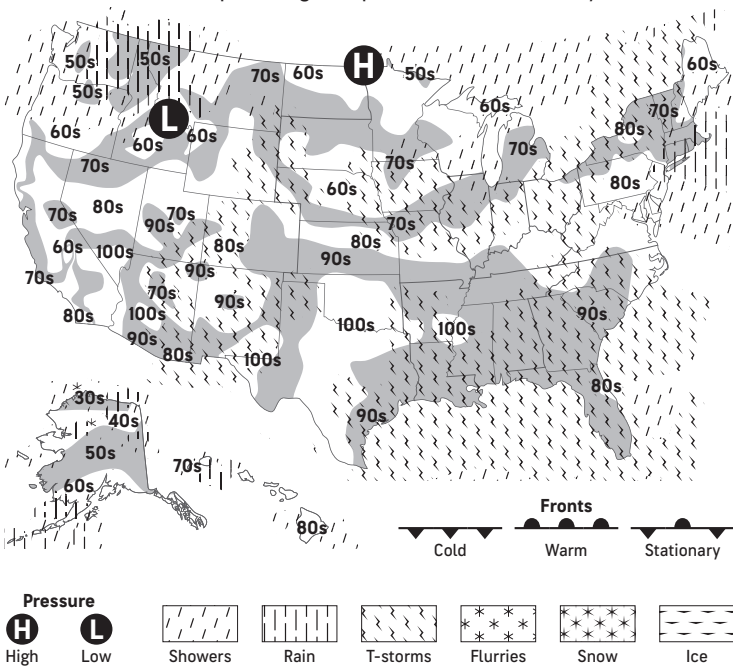


Forecast for Sunday, September 13, 2026
