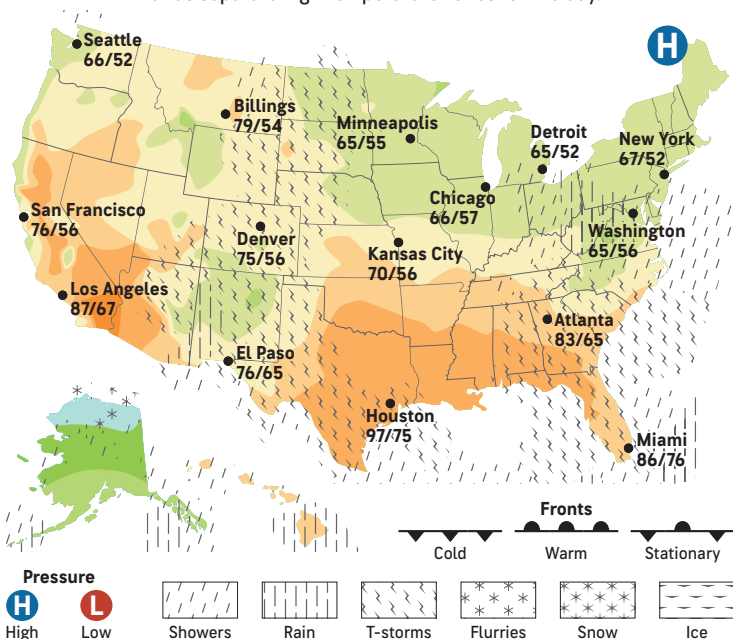


Forecast for Wednesday, September 23, 2026

**NATIONAL SUMMARY:** An influx of tropical moisture will spread thunderstorms from Arizona and New Mexico to the Dakotas tomorrow. There could be flooding, especially in low-lying and poor drainage areas. Spotty storms will dot the Southeast as rain dampens the southern portions of the mid-Atlantic. It will be dry across the rest of the United States.

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
