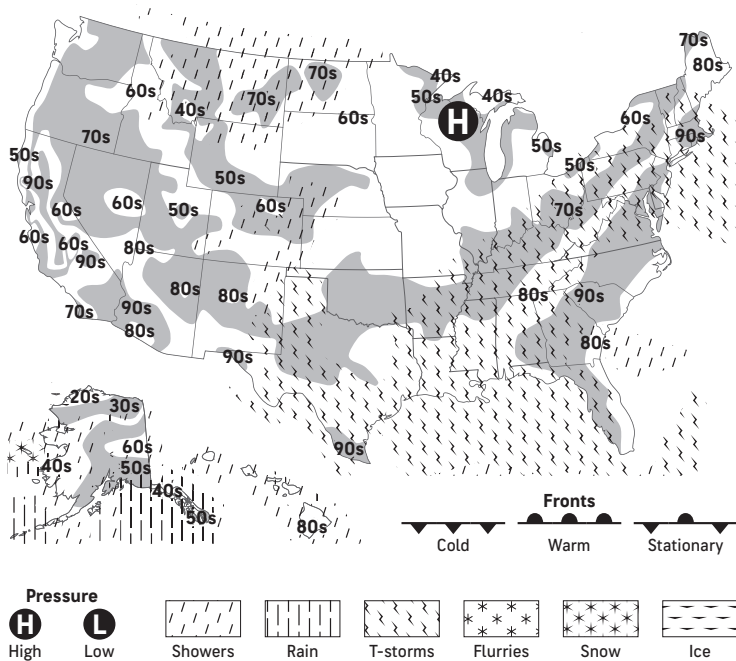


Forecast for Wednesday, May 20, 2026
