Case No. 16AP00415 - SUMMARY of PETITION for ADOPTION

Charlotte R. Lanig, has filed a Petition for the adoption of Thayer Justin Page Lanig a female minor child who has lived in Oregon for more than six months and who is under the age of 14 years and who does not have to consent to this adoption.

Charlotte R. Lanig has been appointed as the child's legal guardian The child has lived at 745 36th Place SE, Albany, OR 97322 since birth.

Thayer Justin Page Lanig is the natural-born child of Stephanie Ryan Lanig and Ryan Anthony Gray is the biological father.

Petitioner is the maternal grandmother of the minor child Thayer Justin Page Lanig and she has, with the except of a couple months, been in Petitioner's custody since birth.

The child is not an "Indian child".

The Oregon Criminal History Information form has been forwarded to the Oregon State Police.

Charlotte R. Lanig loves the child and desires to adopt him to all legal intents and purposes, the same as if he had been born to her. Charlotte R. Lanig is a fit and proper person to adopt Thayer Justin Page Lanig, and has sufficient ability to furnish suitable nurture, having reference to the degree and conditions of the parent.

WHEREFORE, Charlotte R. Lanig prays for a General Judgment of Adoption as follows:

1. That the Court terminate the parent-child relationship of Stephanie Ryan Lanig and Ryan Anthony Gray with Thayer Justin Page Lanig.
2. That the Court make a determination of non-paternity.
3. That Thayer Justin Page Lanig, minor child, be adopted by Petitioner, Charlotte Rae Lanig, so that the Adoptee shall be, to all legal intents and purposes, the child of Petitioner Charlotte R. Lanig the same as if born to her;
4. That the name of the Adoptee, be coninued and hereafter the Adoptee be known as: Thayer Justin Page Lanig
5. That all papers on file herein relating to the personal or family history of the Adoptee be sealed, to remain such and to be unsealed only on judicial order of this Court, as provided by law;
6. For such other and further relief as may be just and proper.
