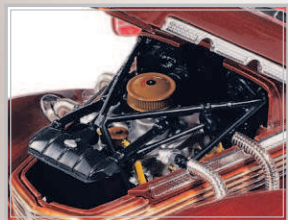

On December 7, 1941, the USS Arizona was destroyed at Pearl Harbor killing 1,177 sailors and Marines. More than a battleship, she symbolized American strength and sacrifice, while her loss propelled the United States into World War II and reshaped global history. Today the memorial above her hull honors those brave souls and the enduring cost of freedom.

Now we commemorate this battleship with the **US Pennsylvania-Class USS Arizona (BB-39) Pearl Harbor 1941**, a 1:700-scale model engineered with a die-cast metal hull; a detailed superstructure; pad-printed markings; realistic panel lines; access panels; and surface details. This battleship replicates the ship’s massive deck with exceptional detail, plus it arrives complete with two interchangeable simulated wood bases for multiple display options.

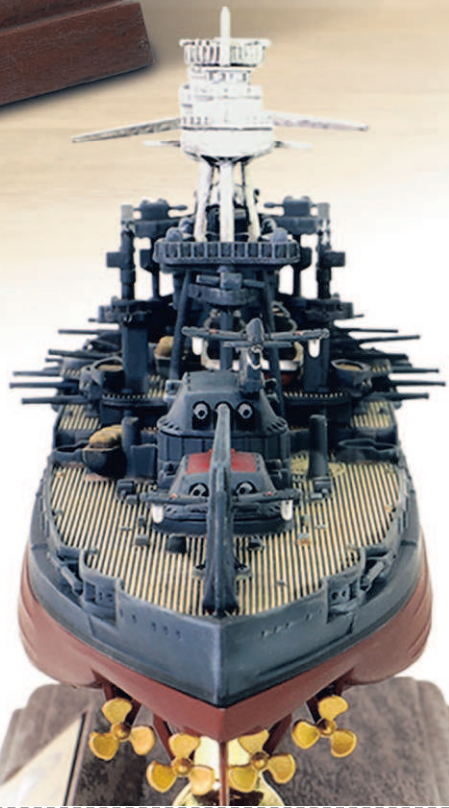
