Dear Mr. Osborn,

We write to you today as women who represent Nebraska families.

Graham Platner faces multiple credible sexual assault allegations. He wrote publicly that women shouldn't get "[f---ed up](#)" over sexual assault. When women came forward with information about his conduct, your lead media consultant [Morris Katz threatened them](#). Your consultant [Daniel Moraff implied nothing Platner has done should disqualify him](#) from the Senate. They both continue to dismiss women's stories.

These men are [running your campaign](#) for the Senate in Nebraska. [You helped recruit Platner](#) to run for the United States Senate. Your [wife's company](#) is [paid by Graham Platner's campaign](#). It is time for you to show that you actually care about vulnerable people, instead of using it as a punchline on a TV ad.

Every woman who has ever found the courage to come forward knows what is at stake when powerful men respond to allegations with threats and dismissal. It sends a message to every survivor watching: your voice does not matter. We refuse to accept that message.

We have spent our public service careers working to strengthen protections for survivors, to ensure women are protected and heard, and to hold accountable those who would silence them. We cannot reconcile that work with staying silent now.

Mr. Osborn, we are calling on you to do two things:

- 1) Fire your campaign consultants Morris Katz and Daniel Moraff immediately. Men who threaten women who come forward and dismiss credible rape allegations should not be running a campaign in Nebraska or anywhere.
- 2) Come clean about how you personally profited from Graham Platner's campaign via your wife's company Dark Forest LLC.

Nebraska women deserve to know that those who seek to represent them will stand with survivors. Young girls growing up in this state deserve to know that their stories will not be dismissed, that they will not be threatened, and that their courage to come forward will not be met with silence from the men who want to represent them.
