WEEK ENDING: February 23, 2020 WATER TEMPERATURE: Top Water 54 degree

The threat of a storm this weekend kept the fishing to a dull roar. Despite that, there were quite a few success stories. Some lures from Rapala, Berkley and SWaver are still coaxing the fish out of the reeds. For those fishing deep, drop shots and Texas rigs are working well. We saw a lot of Senkos and Powerbait worms as well as nightcrawlers. Our water level is still over 70 %, well above the spillway, so no trout plants are planned.

The fishing derby is coming up in April. Our rental slips will fill fast, so make your plans early. We will take reservations for the fishing derby one month prior. Our last boat rental is at 2:30 p.m. and boats must be back in by 4:30 p.m. All of our boats are first come, first serve. Reservations are not available. The weekends are very busy so if you want to rent a Pontoon Boat, it's best to get here early.
