

**TOWN OF LEESBURG**  
**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
**AMENDING TOWN CODE SECTION 32-114 TO**  
**DESIGNATE ADDITIONAL ONE-WAY STREETS**

In accordance with §§ 15.2-1427, 15.2-2028 and 46.2-1300 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, and Part 2, Program 6 of the Town of Leesburg Residential Traffic Management Plan, the Leesburg Town Council will hold a public hearing on:

**Tuesday, January 27, 2026, at 7:00 P.M.**  
in the Council Chambers of Town Hall,  
25 West Market Street, Leesburg, VA

at which time the public will have the right to present oral and written testimony on proposed amendments to Town Code Section 32-114, which will convert the following street segments from two-way to one-way:

- Liberty Street SW between Loudoun Street SW and Royal Street SW (to allow southbound traffic only)
- Wirt Street SW between Royal Street SW and West Market Street (to allow northbound traffic only)
- Royal Street SW between South King Street and Wirt Street SW (to allow westbound traffic only).

Alternative routes with the same termini are as follows:

- Northbound traffic between Royal Street SW and Loudoun Street SW may utilize Wirt Street or S. King Street as alternatives to Liberty Street.
- Southbound traffic between West Market Street and Royal Street SW may utilize Liberty Street or S. King Street as alternatives to Wirt Street.
- Eastbound traffic between Wirt Street SW and South King Street may utilize South Street SW, or Loudoun Street as alternatives to Royal Street SW.
