The object of this suit is to hold a hearing on June 10, 2026 at 3:00 PM for the Petition for Termination of Parental Rights of Unknown Father pursuant to Virginia Code §16.1-283 for Prince Christian Matthew Mott; hold a permanency planning hearing and review of Foster Care Plan pursuant to Virginia Code §16.1-282.1 and §16.1-281 for Prince Christian Matthew Mott. Unknown Father is hereby notified that failure to appear on the hereinafter noticed date and time may result in the entry of an Order approving a permanency goal of adoption as well as the termination of their residual parental rights with respect to Prince Christian Matthew Mott. Unknown Father is hereby further notified that if their residual parental rights are terminated, they will no longer have any legal rights with respect to said minor child, including, but not limited to, the right to visit Prince Christian Matthew Mott; any authority with respect to the care and supervision of Prince Christian Matthew Mott; or the right to make health related decisions or determine the religious affiliation of Prince Christian Matthew Mott. Further, Unknown Father will have no legal and/or financial obligations with respect to Prince Christian Matthew Mott, and the Department of Family Services of Loudoun County, Virginia may be granted the authority to place Prince Christian Matthew Mott for adoption and consent to the adoption of Prince Christian Matthew Mott.

It is ORDERED that the defendant, Unknown Father, appear at the above-named Court and protect his or her interests on or before **June 10, 2026 at 3:00 PM**
