The Loudoun County Department of Transportation and Capital Infrastructure (DTCI) is holding a Design Public Hearing regarding two projects: the proposed traffic signals at Waxpool Road/Ashburn Road and Sterling Boulevard/Glenn Drive.

The **Waxpool Road/Ashburn Road** project plans traffic signalization, signing, and pedestrian improvements at the intersection of Waxpool Road and Ashburn Road/Ryan Corner Place; also, the Waxpool Road and Alexan Terrace intersection will be converted to right-in, right-out turn movements only.

The South **Sterling Boulevard/Glenn Drive** project will add traffic and pedestrian signals to the currently unsignalized intersection. It also features pedestrian safety upgrades, including high-visibility crosswalks and accessible curb ramps at all four corners of the intersection. These improvements are designed to connect to upcoming sidewalk and trail projects on the north and south sides of Sterling Boulevard.
