The Loudoun County Department of Transportation & Capital Infrastructure is holding a Design Public Hearing regarding the proposed Franklin Park to Purcellville Trail Project.

This shared-use path and sidewalk project will provide access for pedestrian and bicycle traffic from the Franklin Park recreational facilities to the existing sidewalk in downtown Purcellville. The project is part of the broader effort to enhance pedestrian and bicycle connectivity and safety between Round Hill and Purcellville.

The proposed project will begin at Franklin Park as a 10-foot-wide shared-use path extending north along Franklin Park Drive and continue east along the north side of Main Street (Business Route 7) toward the Town of Purcellville. As the project enters Town limits, the facility will transition to a 5-foot-wide sidewalk. The sidewalk will terminate at the intersection of Main Street and North 28th Street, where it will connect to the existing sidewalk network.

Additional improvements associated with the project include new signage, pavement markings, drainage enhancements, and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) upgrades. Funding for this project includes local tax funding and state funding allocated through the SMART SCALE program.
