

TOWN OF LOVETTSVILLE NOTICE OF DESIGN PUBLIC HEARING

SOUTH LOUDOUN STREET SCHOOL TRAIL – BERLIN TURNPIKE INTERSECTION TO LOVETTSVILLE PARK DRIVE UPC125693, TAP-5B01(739), TAP-5B01(740), TAP-5B01(741) STATE PROJECT NUMBER (EN24-255-294, C501, P101, R201)

The Town of Lovettsville desires community input on a project under design including: a trail along South Loudoun Street from Berlin Turnpike intersection to Lovettsville Park Drive intersection. The Town will be holding a Design Public Hearing to gain additional input on design elements from the community on **Thursday, October 22, 2026, at 5:00pm** at the Town Council Chambers located at 6 E Pennsylvania Avenue, Lovettsville, VA 20180.

Project Descriptions: Improvements will include installing a shared use path along the west side of South Loudoun Street to connect pedestrians to Lovettsville Elementary School. Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant sidewalks and paths will provide safe pedestrian connections from neighborhoods to the south and west of Lovettsville Elementary School. The work also includes storm drainage culverts and ADA ramps.

This project is funded with a combination of federal, state, county, and local funds. All people desiring to speak will be given an opportunity to do so at this meeting. Written copies of statements are requested but not required. Provide your written or verbal comments at the Public Hearing on the day of the meeting or submit them by November 6, 2026, to Charles Mumaw, PE via email at cmumaw@lovettsvilleva.gov. Members of the public may access and participate in this meeting electronically. The Town's Capital Improvement Plan and preliminary project designs, along with draft Environmental Impact Study, project material plans, and schedules are available for review at the Town Office, 6 East Pennsylvania Avenue, Lovettsville, Virginia 20180, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, holidays excepted, or online at <https://www.lovettsvilleva.gov/projects>.
