

# **ATTENTION NONPROFIT CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS IN LOUDOUN COUNTY**

Nonprofit charitable organizations seeking exemption from Loudoun County real and/or personal property taxes for the 2027 tax year must file an application with the Office of the Commissioner of the Revenue. Completed applications must be postmarked by the April 1, 2026, deadline. If granted, any exemption would become effective January 1, 2027.

Most charitable nonprofit organizations are NOT automatically exempt from local property taxes in the Commonwealth of Virginia, even those that may be exempt from federal income taxes. Filing an application with the Commissioner of the Revenue is the necessary first step to obtaining a local real estate and/or personal property tax exemption.
