The Loudoun County Department of Transportation and Capital Infrastructure is holding a Design Public Hearing regarding the proposed Braddock Road and Trailhead Drive Roundabout project.

This project will construct a new roundabout at the intersection of Braddock Road (Route 620) and Trailhead Drive in Aldie, Virginia. The purpose of the project is to improve traffic operations and safety at the intersection while accommodating existing and future transportation needs. In addition to the roundabout intersection improvement, the project will also include pedestrian and drainage improvements within the project limits.

The project is being administered by Loudoun County in coordination with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT). The project is funded through state revenue sharing funds, general obligation bonds, cash proffers, and local tax revenues.
