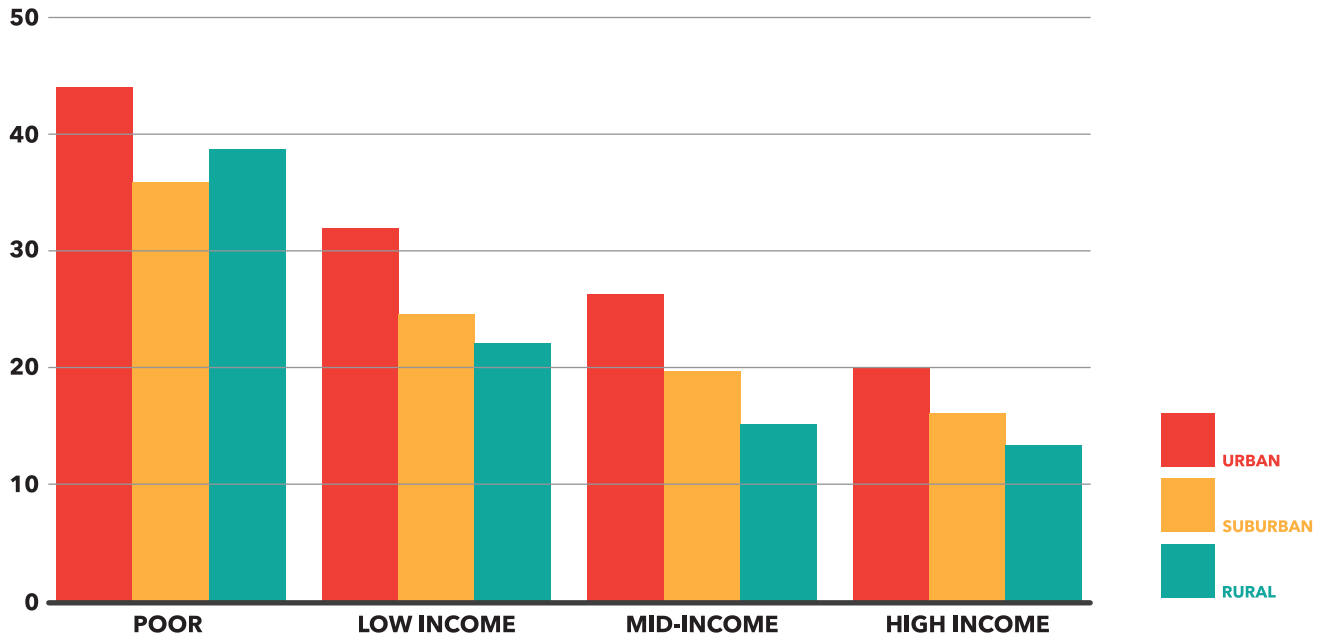


# RATE OF VIOLENT VICTIMIZATION

Note: Poor refers to households at 0% to 100% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). Low income refers to households at 101% to 200% of the FPL.
