Stats., the department may assign confidential status to the information as requested by ChemDesign.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the department has made a preliminary decision to grant confidential status under s. 285.70(2), Wis. Stats., and s. NR 2.19, Wis. Adm. Code, to withhold this information from the public on the basis that public disclosure of such information would have a negative impact on ChemDesign's competitive position in the industry.
