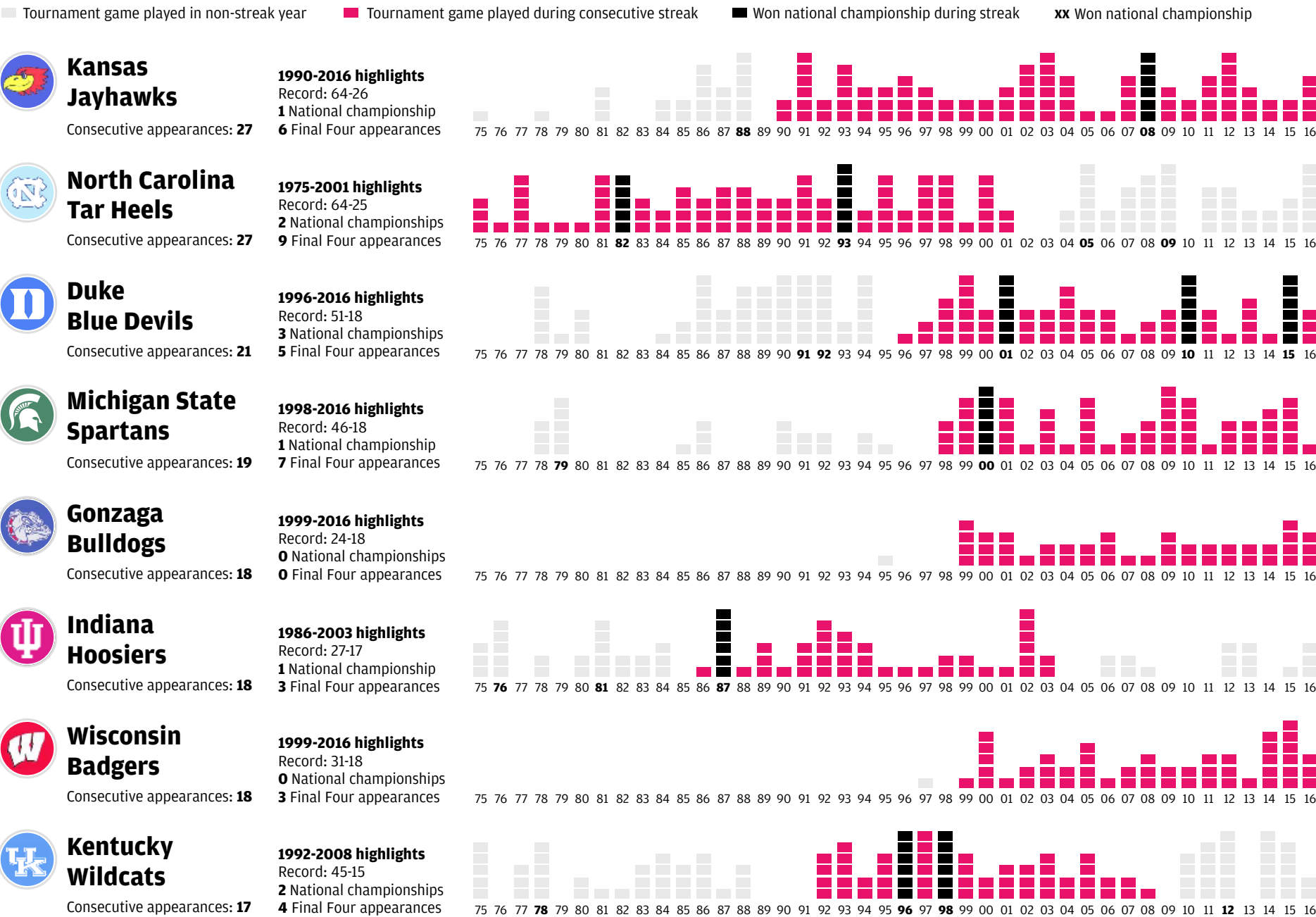


How the streaks stack up

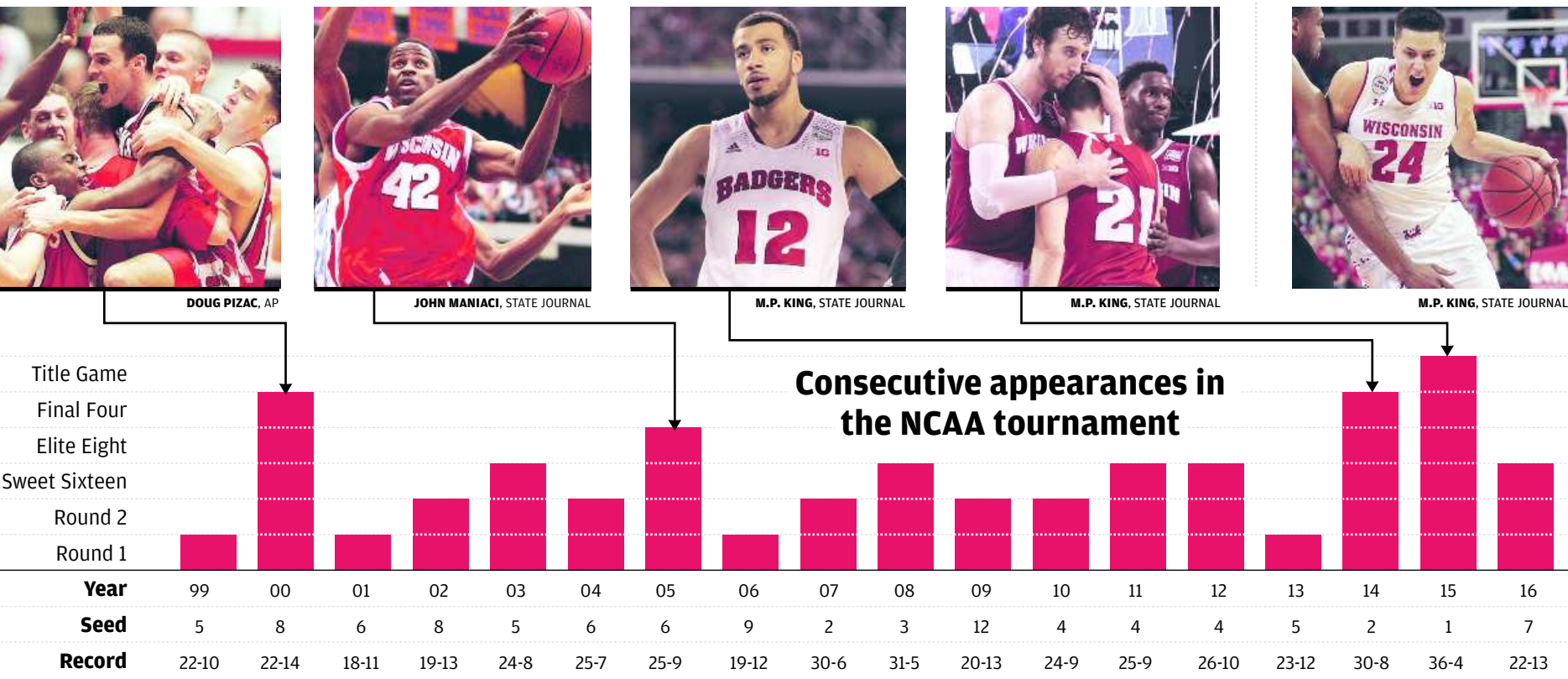
Teams with most consecutive tournament appearances

The University of Wisconsin men's basketball team is well on its way to officially earning a berth in the NCAA tournament for the 19th consecutive season. It's a streak that dates to the 1998-99 campaign and spans four coaches: Dick Bennett, Brad Soderberg, Bo Ryan and Greg Gard. It's also one that puts UW in some exclusive company with college basketball blue-blood programs such as Kansas, North Carolina, Duke, Michigan State, Indiana and Kentucky.

The Badgers upend No. 1 seed Arizona to reach the Final Four for the second time in history and first since 1941. They lose to the Midwest No. 1 seed Michigan State, 53-41.	UW shoots nearly 50 percent from the field (30-for-61), but falls, 88-82, to North Carolina, a No. 1 seed and the eventual national champion.	UW falls to Kentucky in the Final Four, 74-73. The Wildcats win the offensive rebound battle, finishing with 46 points in the paint.	UW eliminates unbeaten Kentucky in the Final Four, but falls to No. 1 seed Duke, 68-63, for the national title.	The Badgers began the season ranked No. 9 in the Associated Press Top 25 poll after returning all five starters from a team that made it to the Sweet 16 the previous March.
