1. Sara Linske (WEC)
 - About/Background
 - i. WEC employee.
 - ii. IT manager
 - iii. Linked in says she is “non partisan” employee.
 - iv. Field Organizer for the Iowa Democratic Party (2014-2015).
 - v. Intern for “Organizing for America.” Was a “Canvassing Captain for three get-out-the-vote” campaigns.
 - Role in election.
 - i. Linske was complicit in feeding data from WisVote or some other WEC database to Hillary Hall, NVAHI, and MSR.
 - ii. She was directly copied on emails asking for data and to complete gaps in data.
 - iii. Provided what appears to be confidential data to the Clerks to give to the SIGs or to the SIGs themselves.
 - iv. Emails specifically requested in depth voter information in a database.
 - v. Verified by email evidence.
2. Hannah Bubacz (City of MKE—GIS Tech).
 - About/Background
 - i. No overt signs of rampant partisanship
 - ii. Linked in is clean.
 - iii. FB is clean.

- iv. Personal GIS projects do not indicate partisanship.
- v. There are indicators that she is probably a democrat.
 - 1. Has a weird nose ring.
 - 2. Colored hair in some pictures.
 - 3. Loves nature and snakes.
 - 4. Lives with BF and they own a house together, but not married.
 - 5. Plays video games.
- Role in 2020 election.
 - i. She is really good at “static maps.”
 - 1. Static maps are standalone images in PNG format that can be displayed on web and mobile devices without the aid of a mapping library or API. They look like an embedded map without interactivity or controls.
 - 2. Static maps may also include overlays like lines, markers, or polygons.
 - ii. She deeply liased with Quickbase to create what appears to be the foundational maps.
 - iii. Quickbase used the data from Bubacz to create the app.
 - iv. She is directly tied by email evidence providing GIS data to QB and MSR for development purposes by email multiple times.
 - 1. Includes providing Hersch information on how to identify individual apartments with MKE GIS data.
