Mitigating Considerations

- No criminal record
- Truthful with investigators in multiple interview sessions (5) in December and January 2010
- Her cooperation was a thing of value to prosecutors, whether or not it produced useful information in the eyes of those prosecutors
- Pledged to honestly cooperate in the prosecution of Tim Russell, in which she has given helpful and detailed information

KR does politics

- Kelly's first preference was not a job in politics. Defense Memo page 2.
- The truth is likely that Kelly would have taken any good paying job in late 2009.
- Indeed, she likely she would have taken a job at any time that paid better than the County.
- Ms. Rindfleisch's job with the Davis campaign is evidence of her need for additional cash.

KR does politics

- The fact remains, however, that Kelly has been employed in the world of politics since 1995 when she was about 26 years old.
- Politics is what Kelly knows and does.
- Based on my review of the e-mails between the campaign and Ms. Rindfleisch, people like Keith Gilkes (FOSW campaign manager) think she does a darn good job of it.

KR does politics

- The point? It is unlikely that she was forced into this criminal conduct by some third parties.
- She found employment based on her skill set.
- This was a world with which Ms. R was familiar.
- This was a world about which Ms. R knew the rules.
