



## SITE CONTEXT

- Village of Cottage Grove is a rapidly developing suburb of Madison
- Dog park site is not far from downtown area, 15 miles from Madison
- Park is close to a major intersection of Highways BB and N
- Park is not connected to existing bike trails or parks but could link to these in the future
- Residential areas close to site will provide many potential park users
- Park will help create a "brand" for the Village, sense of place and a fun destination for residents
- Development can happen in phases over time as budget allows























































