NARRATIVE

INITIAL INFORMATION

On March 17, 2020, at approximately 10:22 am, I was dispatched to make a phone call to Tyeisha Ivy reference Tyeisha wanting to report a threatening text from her daughter's fifth grade teacher.

I made phone contact with Tyeisha who identified her daughter's fifth grade teacher as **Mary Ringelstetter**. Tyeisha explained that with the current situation with the kids not having school she was trying to get her daughter's homework and internet access set up so her daughter could complete homework while school was shut down. Tyeisha was exchanging texts with Mary. Tyeisha explained that after some amount of time she received a text from Mary stating that Mary would like to reach through the phone and slap them. Tyeisha believed that Mary accidentally sent the text to her and that it was probably meant for one of Mary's coworkers. Tyeisha stated that she and her daughter now both feel threatened because Mary had sent the text stating she wanted to reach through the phone and slap them.

Tyeisha stated that she has contacted the principal of the school and is waiting for them to call back. Tyeisha wanted the incident documented. Tyeisha asked me to call Mary and ask Mary not to text or email Tyeisha or Tyeisha's daughter any time in the future.

I was able to make phone contact with Mary. Mary admitted that she did send the text to Tyeisha but that it was meant to go to someone else. Mary stated she never had any real intention to wanting to slap them. She was just frustrated with the situation the crisis going on with the Corona Virus and issues at school. Mary stated that she immediately apologized to Tyeisha after realizing Mary had sent the text to the wrong people. I informed Mary that Tyeisha had asked me to pass along a message that she not contact Tyeisha by email or text and Mary informed me that would not be an issue.

I re-contacted Tyeisha and informed her that I had contacted Mary and passed the message to her that she not contact Tyeisha. I also told Tyeisha that Mary admitted to sending the text and stated it was a mistake and the text was meant for someone else. I informed her Mary realized the text was inappropriate and she is sorry and that she has no plans of ever slapping Tyeisha or her daughter.
