TO THE RUSK COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, the survival of our constitutional republic depends on free and fair elections, where all eligible voters have the opportunity to make their voices heard, and,

WHEREAS, we believe our community has been well-served by the current system of nonpartisan election administration governed by the Wisconsin Election Commission, managed by our County Clerk, and administered by our friends and neighbors who serve as election inspectors, and,

WHEREAS, this County Board of Rusk strongly opposes any future attempts to seize power over elections from municipal clerks and the Wisconsin Election Commission to grant it to any partisan entity, and,

WHEREAS, as long as our non-partisan election administrators continue to administer our elections with accessibility, fairness, equality, safety, and security in mind, we are fully committed to standing behind them in the face of unfounded attacks.

WHEREAS, looking forward to the 2022 election and beyond, we call upon the state legislature and governor to work together to create legislation to provide for safer and secure election, specifically regarding unsecured drop boxes, voter roll integrity, and voting machine security. We call upon and support our municipal clerks, election inspectors, and the Wisconsin Election Commission to follow the prescribed laws in providing for free and fair elections."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Board of Rusk County express full confidence in our municipal clerks, election inspectors, and Wisconsin's system of nonpartisan election administration led by the Wisconsin Election Commission.

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF DEMOCRACY AND NONPARTISAN ELECTION ADMINISTRATION

TO THE RUSK COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, the survival of our democracy depends on free and fair elections, where all eligible voters have the opportunity to make their voices heard, and,

WHEREAS, we believe our community has been well-served by the current system of nonpartisan election administration governed by the Wisconsin Election Commission, managed by our County Clerk, and administered by our friends and neighbors who serve as election inspectors, and,

WHEREAS, these same election officials played a critical role in making the 2020 election safe, secure, and accessible during the COVID-19 pandemic, and,

WHEREAS, over the past year, some in our society have attempted to bully, threaten, and undermine nonpartisan election administrators, making it harder for election officials to do their jobs, which reduces faith in the electoral process and hurts the health of our democracy, and,

WHEREAS, looking forward to the 2022 election and beyond, we reaffirm our conviction that nonpartisan election officials like our municipal clerks, election inspectors, and the Wisconsin Election Commission are best equipped to preside over free and fair elections, and should do so without the fear of threats and intimidation, and,

WHEREAS, this County Board of Rusk strongly opposes any future attempts to seize power over elections from municipal clerks and the Wisconsin Election Commission to grant it to any partisan entity, and,

WHEREAS, as long as our non-partisan election administrators continue to administer our elections with accessibility, fairness, equality, safety, and security in mind, we are fully committed to standing behind them in the face of unfounded attacks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Board of Rusk County express full confidence in our municipal clerks, election inspectors, and Wisconsin's system of nonpartisan election administration led by the Wisconsin Election Commission.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we call on state lawmakers to cease all attempts to undermine, disrupt, or revoke the Wisconsin Election Commission's authority over Wisconsin elections, as well as the authority of municipal clerks.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we support our friends and neighbors who serve as election inspectors and local election officials, including our municipal clerks.
