

Technology Update: February 9, 2015



Devices:

- ✓ Two schools are 1:1-Bickel and Bridge Academy
- ✓ District purchased Chromebooks this year: 415
- ✓ Current devices by school:
 - Perrine: 64 Chromebooks, 97 iPads, and 56 tablets
 - Bickel: 421 tablets and 22 laptops
 - Harrison: 170 Chromebooks and 50 tablets
 - Morningside: 150 Chromebooks 2 Tablets
 - Bridge: 64 Chromebook and 6 tablets
 - Sawtooth: 60 Chromebooks and 27 tablets
 - Lincoln: 121 Chromebooks, 25 tablets
 - Oregon Trail: 42 Chromebooks and 6 tablets
 - Robert Stuart: 160 Chromebooks and 60 tablets
 - O'Leary: 55 Chromebooks and 65 tablets
 - MVHS: 20 Chromebooks
 - CRHS: 317 Chromebooks and 45 tablets
 - TFHS: 60 Chromebooks and 19 Tablets

District Total: 2,184

Total Students: 8,872

Ratio: Approximately 1 device for every 4 students

District money spent (allocation from state): \$150,000

Updated per year expenditure needed to reach 2:1: \$201,000



Computers

- ✓ New computers purchased 200 (goal is 300 per year)

Approximate dollars spent: \$130,000



Blended Learning

- ✓ A cohort of 11 teachers is currently halfway through their first year of blended teaching. They have met monthly with a group of veteran blended teachers and will serve in a leadership role next year for a second cohort (funding dependent).
