IN U.S. CURRENCY

In support of the filing of this Notice, Plaintiff submits the following summary of allegations. The above-styled currency, which was seized on or about the 31st day of March 2026, was furnished or intended to be furnished in exchange for a controlled dangerous substance in violation of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act (UCDSA) and/or was proceeds from such exchange, and/or was used or intended to be used to facilitate a violation of the UCDSA. Said currency was also acquired by the Claimants during a period of a violation of the UCDSA or within a reasonable time after such period and there is no likely source for such property or thing of value other than the violation of the UCDSA. Said currency is thus forfeitable pursuant to 63 O.S. §§ 2-503 (A)(6) and (B).

An OBN agent initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle traveling in Love County, Oklahoma. The driver and sole occupant was identified as Sheng Juan Weng. The agent detected an odor of marijuana when he made contact with Weng. The agent asked Weng about his travel plans and he changed his story before saying he was traveling to Texas for one hour. The agent observed clues consistent with the transportation of illegal drugs or the proceeds of illegal drug transactions. Another OBN agent deployed a K9, who alerted to the odor of illegal drugs. The agents searched the vehicle and found multiple rubber-banded bundles of cash inside the passenger compartment. The currency was seized, and the State of Oklahoma now seeks its forfeiture.

Further notice is hereby given that within forty-five (45) days after receiving this Notice, the owner, claimant, or other party in interest may file a verified answer and claim to the above-described property. Said answer, if filed, is to be filed with the Court Clerk and a copy must be mailed to the office of the General Counsel, 419 N.E. 38th Terrace, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. At the end of forty-five (45) days and if no answer is filed, the State will move the Court for an Order of Forfeiture to the State of Oklahoma based upon evidence upon the facts of the unlawful use of the above-described property in compliance with 63 O.S. § 2-503.
