

# Voter Information for November 5, 2024 General Election

## Excused Absentee Voting

Mail-In Paper Absentee Ballots are available for voters who are:

- Unable to go to the polls due to age, disability, or illness
- A Student who temporarily resides outside the county
- A voter who temporarily resides out of state
- A person incarcerated in jail- Not convicted of a Felony
- A person whose employment location requires them to be absent from the county all hours and all days when absentee voting by machine is conducted
- Military Personnel confined to a Military base on Election Day & Early Voting

## How to Request your Absentee Ballot:

- Go to our online portal at [govote.ky.gov](https://govote.ky.gov) and complete the online application (fastest option)
- If you do not have access to the internet, call **270-240-5771** to request your ballot.

**Ballots can be requested:  
September 21<sup>st</sup>-October 22nd**

*\*When filling out your Mail-in Paper Absentee Ballot, make sure that you sign the inner **AND** outer envelopes, or your vote will **NOT** be counted.  
(This is how your identity will be verified)*

**All Ballots must be returned by mail or placed in the drop box located at:**

Anyone experiencing a medical emergency occurring  
**Oct. 22nd thru Nov. 5th**  
is eligible to receive a **Medical Emergency Paper Ballot.**  
Spouses qualify as well.
