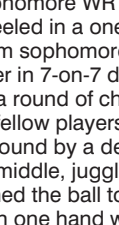

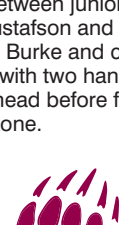
# QUICK KICKS
