THE UNDERSIGNED, BEING A DULY SWORN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER STATES AS FOLLOWS:

I DEPUTY JOHN R. DAVIS ARRESTED DUANE RICHARD THOLEN, THE ABOVE DEFENDANT, FOR THE OFFENSE(S) OF:

ASSAULT WITH A WEAPON IN VIOLATION OF 45-5-213. M.C.A.

ASSAULT WITH A WEAPON IN VIOLATION OF 45-5-213 M.C.A.

AT 1756 HOURS ON THE 20TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2015, AT LIBBY, MONTANA, ON A WARRANTLESS ARREST.

THAT I DEPUTY JOHN DAVIS, BELIEVE THAT THERE IS PROBABLE CAUSE TO HOLD SAID DEFENDANT FOR THE ABOVE STATED OFFENSE(S) BASED ON THE FOLLOWING FACTS:

On the above time and date I was on patrol in a marked vehicle and wearing an approved uniform. Dispatch advised of a possible disturbance that had taken place at 284 Terrace View road. The disturbance was between a school bus driver and an unknown male. The reporting person was Kristan Martin an employee of Harlow's Bus Service.

I spoke to the school bus driver, Janet Kurle, about the incident. Kurle stated that she was waved down by a male while on her bus route on Terrace View rd. Kurle stated that the male was waving his hands back and forth on the side of the road. Kurle stopped the bus and opened the door. Kurle stated that the male stepped one foot up onto the bus and had a knife in his hand. Kurle stated that the male was angry because she was driving too fast. Kurle stated that the male was screaming at her while waving the knife around. Kurle stated that the knife in the males hand was approximately 12" away from her face. Kurle stated that she was very scared and had 5 children still on the bus. Kurle stated that the male stepped out of the bus and she shut the door of the bus on his hand and drove away. Kurle stated that she did not know who the male was. Kurle stated that her adult aid, Jane Smook, was on the bus and witnessed the incident.

I spoke to Smook about the incident. Smook's account of the events was very similar to Kurle's. Smook stated that the male was very angry and screaming at her. Smook stated that the children on the bus were "freaked out". Smook stated that the male was threatening them with the knife. Smook and Kurle both gave me a detailed physical description of the male and the knife. Smook and Kurle also gave a detailed description of the residence on Terrace View where the male apparently resides.

Deputy Boyde White and I responded to 284 Terrace View road. A male matching the description came to the door. The male was later identified as Duane Richard Tholen I asked the Tholen if he knew why I was here? Tholen stated that he had complained about the bus driver. Tholen admitted to waving down the bus and confronting the bus driver about her speeding by his residence. Tholendenied stepping into the bus. Tholen stated that the bus driver was rude to him.

Tholenadmitted to having a knife while working on his truck in the driveway. Tholen initially denied taking the knife on the bus. Tholen later stated that he could not remember if he took the knife on the bus or not. At my request Tholenretrieved the knife in question. The knife Tholenhanded me matched the physical description given by both witnesses.

Smook's statements and account of the incident indicated a reasonable apprehension of bodily harm.

Kurle statements and accounts of the incident indicated a reasonable apprehension of bodily harm.

Tholer was charges with two counts of Assault with a weapon.

I arrested Tholenfor the above charges and transported him to the LCSO Detention Center for booking.
