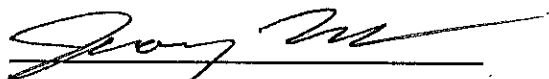
**COMPLAINT**

County, the Defendant committed the offense of COUNT I: SEXUAL ABUSE  
OF CHILDREN, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code  
Ann. 45-5-625(h), punishable by Life or 100 years MSP and a \$10,000 fine.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 19th day of December, 2013, the above-  
named Defendant committed the offense of sexual abuse of children by  
traveling within the state with the intention of meeting a person the  
Defendant believed to be a 12 year old child to engage in sexual conduct.

15 being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

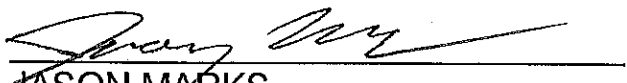

17 I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the  
18 investigation of JUSTIN GALE WALKER for allegedly committing the  
19 offense(s) set forth in the complaint in and based upon the information  
20 contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify  
21 charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying  
22 complaint.

25 On or about the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2013, the Montana Internet  
26 Crimes Against Children task force along with members of the Missoula  
27 Police Department, Missoula County Sheriff's Department, and Flathead  
28

1 County Sheriff's Department began a sting operation targeting people  
2 seeking to have sex with underage girls. They posted ads on Craigslist  
3 and Backpage purporting to be posted by a woman willing to make a 12  
4 year old female relative available for sexual encounters. Officers then  
5 posed as the woman and her 12 year old relative in text message  
6 exchanges and phone conversations with people responding to the ads.  
7

8  
9  
10 On December 19<sup>th</sup>, 2013, Justin Walker responded to the ad. He  
11 expressed an interest in having sex with the 12 year old girl. He insisted on  
12 speaking to the girl and ended up having a phone conversation with an  
13 undercover detective posing as the 12 year old girl. He was given the  
14 address of the house being used for the operation in Missoula.  
15

16  
17 At approximately 2:45 p.m. Walker arrived at the house in Missoula.  
18 He was taken into custody and interviewed. He confessed that he had  
19 come tot eh house for the purpose of having sex with the person he  
20 believed to be a 12 year old girl.
