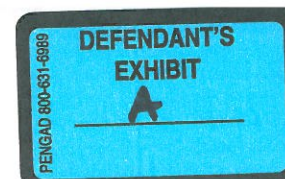

Narrative: Corporal Malone and Officer Hash responded to the area of Gharrett and Garland for a welfare check on a bicyclist who had possibly crashed. The complainant had witnessed the male fall over at this area. Malone made contact with the male, later identified as William Stevens, near the intersection of Gharrett and Cardinal. Malone observed Stevens had a small amount of blood on his chin. Officer Hash arrived on scene and asked Stevens for his ID. Stevens provided an ID, which showed the name **William Stevens**. Malone walked over to his bicycle, and turned it over to check the serial number. Malone asked Stevens who the bicycle belonged to which he shrugged his shoulders, then stood up and said, "Just take me to jail". Stevens continued to walk away in the direction of Malone's patrol vehicle. Stevens stopped just past the rear door, and turned towards officers. Stevens was becoming more and more agitated, and aggressive. Malone told him he did not have to go to jail right at this moment, and asked him to step back in front of the truck. Stevens refused to go to the front of the truck, and then threw something at Malone. Again, Malone told Stevens to stop, but instead he became more aggressive. Stevens looked at Malone, and was assuming a fighting stance. Malone again told him to stop, and he threw something else at Malone which hit the front of his vest.

Because of his current posture, and demeanor, Malone delivered a front kick, aiming for the lower abdominal area. Stevens bent part way over, and stepped away from the truck. Malone grabbed hold of Stevens and took him to the ground. Malone took control of his left hand while Officer Hash took control of his right. Stevens was still struggling with officers however they were able to get him into handcuffs. Officers wanted to get Stevens out of the road as quickly as possible. Malone picked him up and took him around the front of the truck. As they were nearing the grass, Stevens started struggling with officers. Malone used a leg sweep, and tripped him into the grass. Once he was down on the ground, Malone was able to adjust his handcuffs, and double lock them. Stevens was arrested for Assault.
