

THE 2026 CITY OF MONTICELLO FALL LEAF CLEAN-UP

Fall brings beautiful colors to the Monticello area. However, it also drops an overabundance of these colorful leaves on the ground and “leaves” us with question of what to do with them. The City of Monticello will help by providing a Fall Leaf Clean-up. There are a few simple guidelines we ask that you follow, and they are –

- 1. NOTE: LEAVES MUST BE RAKED TO THE EDGE OF THE TERRACE NEXT TO THE CURB.**
- 2. LEAVES CANNOT BE BURNED ON ANY CITY STREET, ALLEY OR OTHER PUBLIC PROPERTY** (*City Code Section #135.08*)
- 3. YOUR LEAVES WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IF THEY INCLUDE STICKS, WALNUTS, YARD WASTE or GRASS CLIPPINGS!!!!**

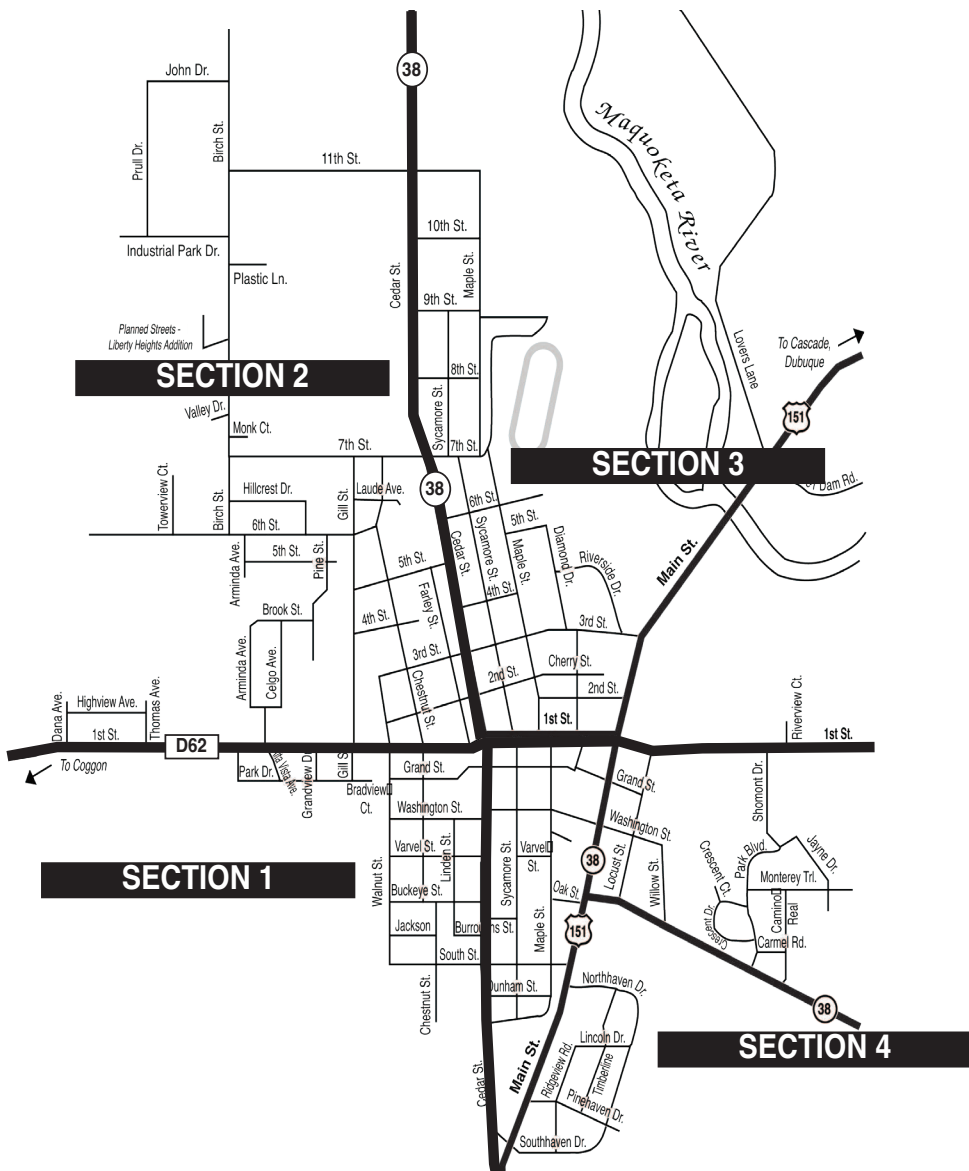
Leaf pick-up dates are –

Oct. 5 thru Nov. 19

Section 1 - Mondays • Section 2 - Tuesdays

Section 3 - Wednesdays • Section 4 - Thursdays

PLEASE NOTE THERE WILL BE NO ROTATION IN SECTIONS



We are asking each resident to please rake leaves to the edge of the terrace next to the curb. City crews will use the Leaf Vac truck for collection.
ONLY LEAVES WILL BE REMOVED!

Any sticks, walnuts or yard waste will need to be placed into curbside containers for the regular “Yard Waste” removal schedule.
