TRADITION CARRIES ON

Thousands flock to destination craft fair

On just a few weeks barricades will go up, Main Street and other parts of downtown will be closed off to vehicular traffic, and Mount Airy will be inundated with shoppers, musicians, craftspeople, music fans, and others.

The Autumn Leaves Festival will get underway the morning of Oct. 11, running through late Sunday afternoon Oct. 13.

“North Carolina’s longest running, most successful events, and is consistently recognized as one of the Top 20 Events in the Southeast by the Southern Tourism Society,” according to officials with the Greater Mount Airy Chamber of Commerce, which is the sponsor of the annual event.

While staff turnover at the chamber has prevented the organization’s officials from being accessible to talk about the upcoming event, the festival is a long-running institution, with a momentum that keeps the event running and successful

“Hundreds of thousands...of visitors have enjoyed the true spirit of America’s Hometown through the rich heritage and scenic beauty that surrounds the community,” the chamber’s leaders have said in past years.

While there is no official count, area officials have estimated that some years more than 200,000 people have visited the festival over the three-day gathering.

Jordon Edwards, who was the Greater Mount Airy Chamber of Commerce’s Autumn Leaves Festival director, said the 2023 edition would include plenty of old favorites among crafters, vendors, food booths and other activities to keep visitors

returning. That was certainly true, as it will no doubt be in 2024.

There also were plenty of new parts of the festival in 2023 to keep things fresh for those visiting Mount Airy. Some of that newness will be returning.

“One big difference...is the expansion of the festival, with the additional footage on Independence,” she said in 2023, speaking of the plans to spread the festival beyond the intersection of Main Street and Independence Boulevard.

That expansion will likely be in effect this year as well. Chamber officials said at the time the festival’s footprint was

expanded that was not done to cram in more vendors. On the contrary, the expansion allowed vendors to spread apart, leaving more room for shoppers to move around among the vendor booths as well as granting easier access to downtown businesses.

Another area of change is more for children to do, Edwards said.

For many years the festival had a few bounce houses and similar activities for kids. The 2023 edition of the Autumn Leaves Festival showed organizers were attempting to put more emphasis on the kids, with jugglers, magicians, different people doing different acts at different times. The

idea was, and is, to make the festival even more of a family event with entertainment for all ages.

That expansion gives families with children more to do, and more opportunities for the kids to have fun.

Another missing piece from past festivals, she said last year, was easy handicapped accessibility.

"The lot off of Moore Avenue has been designated for handicapped parking and merchant parking," she said, adding that downtown merchants who need close parking — without having to pay fees — also will be allowed to use that parking lot.

Of all the changes, Edwards said she was "most excited about" the close handicapped parking, and hopefully that will be in place again this year.

Another addition that dovetails nicely with spreading out the vendors will be seating for folks to utilize while eating. Throughout the festival area she said picnic tables will be located.

While the chamber hasn't officially released this year's hours, the festival typically is up and running 9 a.m. until 9 p.m. on Friday and Saturday, and noon to 5 p.m. on Sunday. The official opening ceremony is generally at 11:30 a.m. on the Friday of the festival.
