n any wedding it's the bride that is the star of the show and nothing helps her to shine more than the wedding gown itself. There are a multitude of things to plan for when it comes to weddings, the venue, the food, the guest list – but the all-important dress for that special day is one of the most iconic parts of any wedding. No one knows that fact better than seamstress Annie Lee Pierce O'Mara.

O'Mara began sewing at age eight. She came from a large family and her mother was an accomplished seamstress who made many of their clothes. O'Mara said with four older sisters at home she often got dresses passed down to her or even wore new things made for her but in the same style as a previous year. She said she took some teasing from classmates because of this. Soon learned to make her own designs and changes to her clothes and the love of sewing as never left her. O'Mara worked at several corporate jobs

over the years and often did alterations and sewing on the side for friends or coworkers but in 2018 she opened her own shop in Jonesville called Blessed Beyond Measure. She began doing all kinds of alterations but two years in she realized the real need was for work on formal wear and wedding gowns.

O'Mara serves customers throughout the region and even out of state, there is such a need for formal wear alterations at a reasonable price. She said her customers are often astonished at the rate she charges compared to the shop where the dress was purchased.

For O'Mara, it's more than just a hem here or a tuck there, her ultimate goal is to customize the gown so it fits the bride "like a glove" and makes them feel as beautiful as possible on their special day.

"Instead of the dress wearing them, I want them to wear the dress and that means a very tailored fit for them, very customized," O'Mara said. O'Mara works closely with brides, based on appointment only, to ensure they are fitted and all the alterations made in a timely manner ahead of the big day, and even earlier to account for bridal portraits made ahead of the wedding.

O'Mara has also seen wedding dress styles change over the decades. She recalled the popular styles of the 1980s through mid-1990s for wedding gowns involved big sleeves, high

necklines and big bows on the back.

"Styles do trend but there's always those classic looks," she noted.

While cleaner lines are more popular now, O'Mara said there is still a lot of variety in the design styles brides are choosing. What she called "textured" gowns with a lace overlay is often popular at more relaxed venues such as the popular wedding barns and outdoor weddings. These gowns can be a little bit looser, not as heavy and more comfortable for brides.

Many brides are going for simple dresses with no beading or rhinestones but then there are some still choosing gowns with lots of appliques or even scalloped hemlines.

As far as sleeves, O'Mara said most of this year's dresses she has worked on thus far are sleeveless but brides are now requesting modifications that can be changed out on the gown either for pictures or after the ceremony.

"They like when I can alter those dresses and make them flexible," she said. "So I will design sleeves for them that they can attach either with snaps or hooks and eyes so they can take them off."

While its always been tradition to get married in white, O'Mara said many brides are moving away from that. Since she opened her shop she said she has probably only done a dozen or so true white wedding gowns. A very pale pink color known as blush is becoming increasingly popular O'Mara said. She's also done several black wedding dresses, a few in different

shades of blue and even an orange wedding gown.

When it comes to the bridal party, O'Mara said cinnamon and terra cotta are the hot colors this fall. Greens in shades from a deep pine green to sage are also popular. O'Mara said brides are also offering their wedding party more choices these days when it comes to selecting bridesmaid dresses. Sometimes they just tell them a color and let them order something online in a style that fits them, she explained.

Even for wedding gowns, purchasing online is becoming a trend, O'Mara said.

"There are some challenges to those," O'Mara said of wedding dresses purchased online, but it can be a cost saving over purchasing from a boutique and she's happy to work with brides to make it perfect for them.

"I don't care what you paid for your dress, I feel like you should feel beautiful on your wedding day and I do not let them leave my store with their garment unless they are 100 percent satisfied."

Using vintage or hand-me-down family gowns is another trend some brides are going towards.

O'Mara recently had a bride who purchased a vintage wedding gown from the 1960s with pleats, something that's

very unusual now. The bride plans to pair the gown with her mother's veil from 1983. Another bride O'Mara has worked with had her mother's wedding gown shortened and altered to wear to the wedding rehearsal. O'Mara said they brought the gown to her shop where the bride, mother and grandmother opened the seal on the box the gown had been stored in years before. There were tears all around, she said. As a special surprise for the mother of the bride, O'Mara also used appliques from the daughter's dress paired with the bow from the mother's wedding dress and created a shadowbox keepsake.

"It's exciting," she said of special projects like that.

O'Mara doesn't just work on making brides shine for the big day. While many grooms and groomsmen do choose to rent tuxedos, there are still some who purchase suits that need altering. She sometimes even creates custom bow ties or pocket squares for the grooms using fabric hemmed from the bridesmaids gowns so it's a perfect match. She said she sometimes does this for prom couples too.

The name of O'Mara's shop — Blessed Beyond Measure— is fitting for her as she says she feels blessed to have this skill and talent and loves her job making sure brides look picture perfect for their special day.
