It's almost time for shorts, swimming, and popsicles, which means it's also time for Summer Reading at Hailey Public Library. The theme for this summer's program is *Unearth a Story*. Sign-ups for kids of all ages begin Tuesday, May 26, and continue throughout the summer. Summer reading officially starts June 3 and wraps up on the 31st of July with our annual celebration honoring readers and their accomplishments. The Summer Reading Program encourages kids and families to keep reading during the school break, when many students experience the "summer slide," a decline in literacy skills. It's also a fun way to stay connected with friends and family. The program is free and will look familiar to returning participants. Parents of babies and toddlers track how many books they read together, elementary-age readers complete sticker charts based on time spent reading, and older students take on a Bingo-style challenge. Participants who reach their goals are entered into a drawing to win prizes, including a Yoto player and AirPods.

In addition to many *Unearth a Story* reading activities, we'll offer additional Science, Technology, Reading, Engineering, Arts & Math (STREAM) programs all summer. The Hunger Coalition will be back with nutritious free meals, too! Hailey Public Library looks forward to helping kids enjoy a creative, enriching, and book-filled summer.
