Ability Montana - Promoting

independence for people with disabilities. Ability Montana offers assistance, services, and information to enable people living with disabilities to live as independently as they choose. They hire personal care attendants that provide care in the home.

Aware, Inc - A statewide nonprofit organization that offers quality, communitybased support for people with mental health and/or developmental disabilities and families with children ages 0 to 8. They serve all 56 counties in Montana.

BSW - A haven for those with disabilities and special needs. BSW, previously known as Butte Sheltered Workshop, has played a big role in Butte providing work experience for developmentally disabled children and adults. BSW offers offices, day programs, training in wood-working and other trades, residential facilities and thrift stores.

Community Counseling & Correctional Service - A team of individuals dedicated to meeting the human service needs of youths and adults to promote healthy living through treatment, training, and supervision.

Copper Ridge Nursing and Rehabilitation Center - Providing nursing and rehabilitation services in the community since 1974. Copper Ridge currently employs over 100 people and continues to be a partner with both local and out of state healthcare providers. Their first priority is the wellness of their patients.

Easter Seals-Goodwill - Changing people's lives across our four-state region through job skills training, disability, health care and children's services. Every day, they create opportunities for individuals with diverse needs and backgrounds to live as independently as possible.

Fairmont Hot Springs Resort - Nestled in the foot of the Anaconda Pintler Wilderness; located between Glacier National Park and Yellowstone National Park. Fairmont Hot Springs Resort is one of the most complete resort destinations in Montana. The resort is popular with families, business people, conventioneers and travelers from Montana, the United States, and the world.

Montana Precision Products - An aerospace manufacturing company based in Butte, MT. It is a joint venture between GE and SeaCast. They are an AS9100 certified aerospace manufacturing facility. They produce tube and duct assemblies and small structural castings for aerospace and commercial applications. **Safeway** - An American supermarket chain founded by Marion Barton Skaggs in April 1915 in American Falls, Idaho. The chain provides grocery items, food and general merchandise and feature a variety of specialty departments, such as bakery, delicatessen, floral and pharmacy, as well as Starbucks coffee shops and fuel centers.

Southwest Montana Community Health Center - Opened its doors in 1986 under the name Butte-Silver Bow Primary Healthcare Services Inc. SWMTCHC is a mission-driven private, nonprofit organization governed by a community volunteer board of directors. The clinic is partially funded through a grant through the federal government that allows it to offer discounts on services so that healthcare remains accessible and affordable. The clinic cares for more than 13,500 patients annually and employs more than 170 people in its various locations.

TTEC Agility (Formerly FCR) - A company which helps digitally native companies with their customer support grow. Now with the capability to help companies jump-start their CX transformation journeys.

REC (Advanced Silicon Materials) - A global leader in silane-based, high-purity silicon materials. REC Silicon ASA is a leading producer of advanced silicon materials, supplying high-purity polysilicon and silicon gases to the solar and electronics industries worldwide.

Montana Resources - One of The Washington Companies, has operated in Butte since 1985, continuing the mining tradition here. Montana Resources operates an open pit copper and molybdenum mine in Butte, Montana. The operation comprises the Continental mine, crushers and a concentrator facility where tons of raw ore are processed into high-quality metal concentrates. They serve an international market for these important metals.

Town Pump has owned and operated hotels across the state and in Idaho for over 35 years. In many communities, Town Pump offers on-site and standalone car washes. The Town Pump Charitable Foundation provides financial support to nonprofit organizations that help meet the basic needs and eduction of Montana citizens.

NorthWestern Energy - For more than 100 years, NorthWestern Energy has been committed to delivering safe, reliable and innovative energy solutions. 

Bell-Mont Properties (BMP) – The original location of Old Dominion, the cross-docking facility, is currently leased by Albertson's.

Ergon Asphalt and Emulsions – Manufacturers and markets liquid asphalt pavements and asphalt products. Western States Asphalt began construction of their new facility in 2019. In 2020, the new facility was purchased by Ergon Asphalt.

FedEx Freight – A LTL trucking company. FedEx Freight opened their facility in Montana Connections in 2010. FedEx has made two additions to the facility since the original construction was completed: a truck service center and parking and fencing expansion in 2019.

German Gulch Development – A partnership between the local government and a developer to develop a parcel of land that is shovel ready, began in 2016. To date we have constructed 3 of the 6 buildings that were planned for the parcel with mixed ownership and uses.

• **Bio-Squeeze** – A new company to Montana Connections specializes in bio cementation applications.

• Connections Café – A drive through breakfast, lunch and coffee restaurant.

• Let's Get Moving – A last mile delivery carrier that moved to Montana Connections in 2020 and occupies a 12,000-sf building.

• Septic Net – The first tenant in the German Gulch Development. Currently located in 6,000 sf of manufacturing space. Septic Net is an innovative, patented modular septic treatment system.

Montana Craft Malt – A 10,000-ton craft malting facility.

Montana Precision Products – Aerospace manufacturer SeaCast of Montana completed construction in partnership with Butte-Silver Bow on their facility in 2010. The original building was a 66,000-sf facility. A Joint Venture with GE was entered into creating Montana Precision Products and in 2019 SeaCast started the process of expanding the facility by another 40,000 sf. **Murdoch's** – This location is the warehouse and distribution center for the home and ranch supply company. Murdoch's has completed construction on an 80,000-sf warehouse and distribution center.

National Guard Readiness Center – A new Readiness Center is being constructed in Montana Connections. Construction started in 2023 and is expected to be complete by 2025. This will be a replacement for the existing Readiness Center in Butte near Stodden Park.

Nelson Family Enterprise – A warehouse and distribution facility constructed in 2015.

Old Dominion – A LTL trucking company. Old Dominion has been in Montana Connections since 2009. In 2019, they moved out of a leased space and constructed their own larger building.

Port of Montana – A full service transloading facility, served by BNSF and UP.

REC Silicon – A Polysilicon and Silane gas manufacturer. Originally, Advanced Silicon Materials Inc. (ASiMI), completed construction in 1997. ASiMI later became REC Silicon and was one of the first industrial developments in Montana Connections.

Scoular Company – An agribusiness supply chain company that buys, sells, transports and stores grain. Scoular is one of the original businesses in the Montana Connections and is served by Union Pacific railway.

Solvay USA LLC - A Member of the Syensqo Group – A closed Phosphorus Plant currently completing cleanup activities.

Town Pump – Transloading and fuel storage facility.

WAUSAU – A warehouse and distribution center for the building materials supply company. WAUSAU constructed a 150,000-sf warehouse and distribution center that opened 2021.



The university is perched high on the hillside above Butte, and is an iconic piece of the city's historic skyline. The 100-acre main campus offers access to the local trail system, a mountain bike skills course and is located in a recreational paradise with snow-capped mountains, blue-ribbon rivers and millions of acres of public lands in every direction.

In addition to finding their place on the hiking trails, Montana Tech students are committed to finding their career path. Tech's north campus offers bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees. The university's high-demand degrees prepare students for careers in various settings. The university's Highlands College is home to career-ready and transfer programs that help build the workforce needed to better lives in our community, state and beyond. From certificates and associate degrees to community education and customized training, Highlands College offers relevant hands-on professional programs that lead to tomorrow's vital jobs. Highlands College is a premier regional center for workforce development and workforce-ready students through entry-level, continuing education and reskilling opportunities designed to meet industry demands. Highlands College graduates meet the workforce needs of our community, southwestern Montana and our state and region.

The Montana Tech campus artfully blends historic architecture with state-of-the-art facilities. The Lesar Family Nursing Simulation Center allows nursing students to use real-life simulation opportunities throughout the nursing curriculum. The Student Success/Living Learning Center provides an environment for students to live, learn, gather and develop lifelong friendships. The university houses one of the country's most high-tech nanotechnology clean labs and a state-of-the-art Hitachi HT7820 scanning/transmission electron microscope. The addition of the microscope is significant for research regionally, as it is one of the most advanced in Montana. Another unique feature on campus is the Underground Mine Education Center (UMEC), a hands-on, interdisciplinary educational space consisting of the former Orphan Boy and Orphan Girl Mines located immediately west of campus. It is the nation's only on-campus underground mining facility, and is home to courses for mining engineering, geological engineering, environmental engineering, metallurgical engineering and occupational safety and health. It also serves as a research facility. Montana Tech also houses the state's only SAP Next-Gen Lab, which offers students access to a number of System Applications and Products in Data Processing (SAP) proprietary software programs that perform data analytics and export graphics that give business professionals easily digestible information to make decisions easier. The university offers students a variety of extracurricular opportunities and clubs and organizations to be a part of. Montana Tech students are determined doers. The university has produced ten Goldwater Scholars and five Honorable Mention Scholars. The award is the most prestigious undergraduate scholarship awarded in America's natural sciences, mathematics and engineering.

Montana Tech's commitment to research has resulted in significant growth. The museum showcases many specimens on display, a gift shop, and several exhibits describing Montana's geology, earthquake activity and local mining history.

The SWMTCHC offers a sliding fee schedule that allows it to adjust charges for healthcare services according to family income. In addition, SWMTCHC accepts Medicare, Medicaid, Healthy Montana Kids and private health insurance plans. SWMTCHC consistently ranks as one of the top healthcare centers in the state for its patient outcome and quality metrics for the services provided. 

Neighborhoods







Butte-Silver Bow Law Enforcement Department





The mission of the Butte-Silver Bow Law Enforcement Department is to protect life and property from criminal activity and maintain the public peace and safety by enforcing the law. Activities of the law enforcement department include arresting and detaining suspects committing or attempting to commit criminal offenses, serving legal papers, suppressing breaches of the peace, riots, or insurrection, investigation of crimes and administration of various community relations programs.

The Butte-Silver Bow Law Enforcement Department is a professional police department and is the only law enforcement department serving the City and County of Butte-Silver Bow. The law enforcement department is the result of the consolidation of the Butte Police Department and the Silver Bow County Sheriff's Department that occurred in 1977. Butte Law Enforcement works closely with the Montana Highway Patrol, the Montana Division of Criminal Investigation and other state and federal law enforcement entities.

Butte-Silver Bow Law Enforcement is led by an elected sheriff. The current sheriff is Ed Lester, a 34-year veteran of law enforcement in Butte- Silver Bow. The sheriff also oversees the operation of the Butte-Silver Bow Emergency Dispatch Center and the Butte-Silver Bow Detention Center.

The Law Enforcement Center is located at 225 N. Alaska Street in Butte. There is a memorial to the 18 law enforcement officers who have given their lives in service to the citizens of Silver Bow County located in front of the Law Enforcement Center. The detention center is located nearby, at 155 W. Quartz Street. The law enforcement department is divided into three divisions. They are: The patrol division, investigative division, and the detention center. The department also has a Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team as well as a number of trained hostage negotiators.

Butte Law Enforcement is part of the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (ICAC) and has placed an investigator on the Southwest Montana Drug Task Force (SWMDTF). A canine unit has also been added to increase drug enforcement capabilities. The department also has 2 School Resource Officers (SRO's) and a Public Housing Authority Officer.

Nearly all sworn personnel, 911 Communication Officers and Detention Officers are trained in Crisis Intervention Techniques to better interact with persons who are in crisis.

The law enforcement department currently has 53 sworn law enforcement officers, 12 dispatchers, 29 detention officers and approximately 15 other civilian employees.

The Butte-Silver Bow Law Enforcement department responded to over 31,000 calls for service and made over 2000 arrests in 2023.

The men and women of the Butte-Silver Bow Law Enforcement Department are well trained professionals who are devoted to serving the citizens of Butte-Silver Bow and our visitors.



Each of the nine volunteer fire departments has its own command structure and elected board of district trustees. Volunteer staffing varies but typically runs in the range of 120 volunteer firefighters.

• The Fire Department budget supports 14 facilities including the Silver Bow Fire Training Center and a fleet comprised of 39 pieces of fire apparatus and support vehicles.

• Insurance Services Office (ISO) Public Protection Classification is a split classification- 4/10. Their most recent reviews and improvement of the Public Protection Classification was the result of several years of hard work and cooperation between several local government agencies.

MISSION STATEMENT

Our purpose is to enhance the Butte Economy through promoting and supporting sporting and related events in Butte.

BACKGROUND

Advantage Butte was founded when a group of local business leaders recognized sporting events bring millions of dollars annually into our community. Most of these events can be self-supporting. Many of the potential sponsors of these events, however, lack the resources to provide some of the initial funding to attract and promote the events or lack the resources to cover potential shortfalls. By bringing together broad-based support from throughout the community, the group can provide the financial resources to allow event sponsors to compete effectively in the state and regional market.

Advantage Butte provides economic development for Butte through the sponsorship / underwriting of sporting events in the community. The easiest way to measure the success Advantage Butte has had is the number of tournaments we have hosted. Since our organization was founded in 2004, through the spring of 2023, the number stands at over 165. The financial impact of these tournaments is just over \$45.7 million dollars added to our local economy.

Since Advantage Butte is a 100% volunteer organization, all money raised goes to the successful bidding and hosting of tournaments. Advantage Butte has always relied on donations from the Butte business community to create economic development.

MEASURING IMPACT

The Montana Chamber of Commerce has established a formula to assist communities in measuring the economic impact generated by sporting events.

• Each team member is valued at \$100 per day. (avg. team is 18 players)

• Each team brings two fans per athlete -- the exception to this is the class C boys' basketball, the largest single basketball tournament in the state. Each fan is valued at \$100 per day.



Butte-Silver Bow Convention & Visitors Bureau (CVB)

The Butte CVB and TBID utilize funds collected from the lodging industry to promote Butte's tourism assets to visitors with the goal of keeping people in the community longer, spending money in restaurants, retail, attractions and overnights. Promotion is primarily done through targeted digital, online and social media platforms. Butte works closely with the larger entities of BrandMT (Montana Department of Commerce) and the travel region Visit Southwest Montana in joint venture programs allowing promotional dollars to go further.

The Butte CVB is funded through the 8% "bed tax" collected by lodging properties; hotels, campgrounds and short-term rentals (Airbnb and VRBO). The "bed tax" is divided down with 3% going to Montana state general fund, 1% to fund Montana Heritage and Historic Preservation projects. The remaining 4% is further divided down to assist in funding: MT Department of Commerce (including the Montana Film Commission), MT Fish, Wildlife and Parks, MT Heritage Preservation and Development, Montana university system for travel research, MT Department of Commerce, Aquatic Invasive Species, MT State Parks, Indian tourism region, six tourism regions and 17 Convention & Visitors Bureaus (CVB). The Butte CVB's had a projected budget of \$192K for promotional purposes.

An annual marketing plan is developed approval given by the Governor's appointed Tourism Advisory Council. At the end of each fiscal year, an extensive audit is conducted on all bed tax expenditures followed by an evaluation on expenditures.

Besides promotion, bed tax dollars are spent to support administrative expenses, and research to assess where visitors originate, where they go, and how their funds are expended.

Butte Tourism Business Improvement District (TBID)

The Butte Tourism Business Improvement District (TBID) was created in July 2011 at the request of Butte hoteliers, to build a promotional fund to increase hotel guest room sales and revenue. In June 2021 the TBID was extended for another ten years. A board of trustees oversees the TBID budget and expenditures is comprised of hotel owners or designees, they are appointed by the Butte-Silver Bow Chief Executive and approved by the Butte-Silver Bow Council of Commissioners.

Butte lodging facilities collect \$1.00/occupied guest room/night from hotel guests. The collected funds vary between \$250K-\$280K annually. The TBID accepts grant applications for promotional funding of events, tournaments, and special projects in two funding cycles; January and June, with award decisions made by the board of trustees in February and July. Additionally, the TBID spends funds on promotional campaigns, and administrative costs associated with carrying out the work for the organization.





Butte 100 - July 20



We will be celebrating the 18th Annual Butte 100 Mountain Bike Races on July 20, 2024. Starting in 2007 as a small group of mostly locals, the Butte 100 has seen substantial growth in its short history. The race has recently been recognized in nationwide publications as an ultimate test of mountain biking physical and mental aptitudes. A focus of the volunteer-staffed race is continued improvement in racer experience each year. The Butte 100 is proud to be contributing to the growing awareness of Butte, Montana as a world-class recreation city.

Though this entire event is named the "Butte 100", it consists of three individual races: the 25 mile, 50 mile and 100 mile, run in conjuction and support of the other, sharing portions of course, supplies and aid stations and the start/finish area.

The IOO-mile racers will endeavor to complete a full figure-8 course that includes pedaling the equivalent of climbing Mt. Rainier. Only the 100's will experience the desert riches awaiting them in the BLM's Pipestone area. As the 100s are hammering the top portion of the "figure-8," the 50-milers begin the daunting southern portion of the "8." The 100's return through the start/finish area before taking on the now warmed-up southern loop.

The 50-mile course (south loop) is known for the notorious 6-mile Basin Creek Climb that looms over all racers-50s and 100s alike-halfway through the loop. Those surviving this and the ensuing "8 Miles of Hell," are greeted with a silky 35-mile stretch of single-track on the USFS maintained Continental Divide Trail-the jewel in the Butte 100s crown. A downhill finish reawakens racers from their trail trance and wills them across the finish line.

The Sorini 25, which was added in 2015 was named after Dr. Peter Sorini, who raced in the 50 and 100 mile races numerous times and

supported the Butte 100 since day one. The Sorini 25 has a new course which racers love. Dr. Peter Sorini passed away on February 8, 2016, after a I4-month battle with brain cancer.

The Butte 100 is incredibly proud to have developed one of the nation's best mountain bike race events, attracting the highest caliber of racers from across the country and Canada. More so, the race is just as proud of the positive effects the race has had on our community, including its contribution to conversations spotlighting Butte's abundant recreational opportunities. We welcome spectators to come out and cheer these racers on. The start/finish is a great way to connect with our racers, sponsors and volunteers. There is music, food and cold beer.



Altogether, Butte-Silver Bow's park sites total more than 450 acres of developed and undeveloped park land providing both active and passive recreation opportunities for residents of Butte-Silver Bow and the surrounding areas, supplemented by the incredible public lands and open spaces in the Butte-Silver Bow area.

There are nearly 45 developed parks and 60 miles of recreational trails (approximately 27.5 miles paved) in Butte-Silver Bow. The parks amenities include skating rinks, cross country skiing, a skate park, tennis, basketball volleyball, and pickleball courts, a wading pool, splash pad, water park, cemetery, an all-abilities accessible playground, sports fields, 9-hole golf course, par 3 golf course, driving range and two folf courses. The Highland View Golf Course also offers two year-round indoor golf simulators, and full-service restaurant and a bar with beer and wine available.

Butte-Silver Bow natural areas include Thompson Park, a 3,800-acre forested park south of Butte, co-owned and co-managed by the U.S. Forest Service; Big Butte is 310 acres; Skyline Park is 60 acres; Basin Creek Reservoir is 42 acres; and Blacktail Creek is 10 acres. Butte-Silver Bow organizes adult sports including softball, pickleball and volleyball. Partnerships with local youth organizations provide recreation opportunities including little league, football, tennis, soccer and ice skating.

Thompson Park provides non-motorized day-use trails for hiking, mountain biking, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, and horseback riding, picnic areas and a regulation disc golf course. Skyline Park provides a children's fishing pond, off leash dog parks, all-abilities accessible playground, walking trails and a hang gliding landing site. Big Butte provides non-motorized trails for hiking and mountain biking. Stodden Park is home to Ridge Waters, Montana's newest family waterpark, Highland View Golf Course, the Spirit of Columbia Gardens Carousel and a destination playground which is all abilities accessible.





Montana Folk Festival



The Montana Folk Festival is set to return to Uptown Butte for its 12th presentation this July 12, 13, and 14. After three years as the National Folk Festival from 2008-2010, this will be the 15th presentation of this much anticipated and widely acclaimed event.

The festival is a three-day celebration of traditional music, dance, arts and ethnic cuisine. Thanks to the generosity of our sponsors and attendees who make contributions on the site, admission to all is free for all performances and exhibitions.

The festival is one of the largest free of admission outdoor events in the Northwest, attracting well over 150,000 attendees each year from throughout Montana and surrounding states and Canada.

This signature event at the beginning of the summer season has grown to become a major economic and cultural magnet for Butte and Southwest Montana.

While admission to all performances is free of charge, attendees are encouraged to consider a suggested \$20 contribution each day of the festival weekend or \$25 for families each day to keep the festival free in future years.

"Each year, we focus on a theme that highlights an important aspect of Montana's heritage," said George Everett, Festival Director and Festival Executive Committee Member.

The theme when selected later in the Spring will guide the activities, displays and demonstrations of the popular Montana Folklife Area and will include demonstrations and displays by a variety of Montanans who have contributed to the vitality and culture of the West.

"Meanwhile, musical performers on multiple stages will continue to represent musical traditions from around the world that have contributed to the heritage of our nation on the six performance stages," Everett added. "The quality and excitement that fans have come to expect at the festival and the rich variety of the performers will continue. Attendees should come expecting to be amazed -- and bring their dancing shoes."

From 1955 until 1982, the Berkeley Pit produced enough copper to pave a four-lane highway, four inches thick, from Butte to Salt Lake City, Utah and 30 miles beyond. When mining operations ceased in 1982, the underground pumps were shut off, and



the Berkeley Pit began filling with acidic water, heavy metals and unique microscopic lifeforms. Since September 2019 the water is being treated and discharged downstream. The Pit with its water and colorful land-scape can be seen via a visitor viewing stand. Today, open pit mining continues behind the Berkeley Pit in the Continental Pit operated by Montana Resources, employing 350 people year-round. The Viewing Stand and Gift Shop are open May – mid-September.



Butte is the home to two golf courses: Highland View municipal course and the Butte Country Club course.

As the name suggests, Highland View has a wonderful view of the Highland Mountains south of town. The regulation nine-hole course was built in 1939. It is a par 35. This course has two challenging par 3 holes. Small greens require accuracy and different tees are used for the back nine. It takes about two hours to play even when busy. The par 3 course was built in 1980, and has a full swing on every hole. The greens are excellent with a lot of character. It's great fun for all members of the family and a nice walk in the park.

When it comes to indoor golf, no other place compares to the recently completed Highland View Clubhouse. With two Trackman Golf Simulators, golfers can practice all aspects of the game with access to over 200 golf courses. Grab a couple pals and enjoy the game in a controlled environment and assistance from our professional staff. After indoor or outdoor golf relax in the Jack Crowley Jr. clubhouse or sit on the deck overlooking Butte's Highland Mountains. The Back 9 Sports Bar and Grille is now open in the clubhouse.

The course is host the Men's City Championship in July and the Bonnie Highlanders Women Invitational in August, along with local charity fundraiser golf tournaments. Highland View is located in Butte's Stodden Park. The park entrance is off Dewey Boulevard on South Utah Avenue. The Butte Country Club is a member-owned private country club that provides its members golf, racquetball, swimming, simulation golf and fine dining opportunities. The course is an 18-hole, challenging par 70. The club also provides a driving range to master technique or warm up before a round.

The Butte Country Club is located at 3400 Elizabeth Warren Ave. Both of Butte's courses offer golf lessons.



Less than 20 miles outside of Butte, there is another option for golfing at Fairmont Hot Springs Resort. Fairmont's golf course features an outstanding 6,74I yard, 18-Hole, par 72 layouts. Fairmont's "mile high, mile-long" 5th Hole is recognized as one of the most challenging among Montana golf courses. The green is a mile high and the tee box is 649 yards away, making this par 5 one of the longest holes in Montana. Fairmont's 3rd hole features Montana's largest green, a three-tiered 10,000-square-foot putting surface.

Over the last three seasons, Fairmont completed over \$2 million in renovations to the golf course. Projects included rebuilding all of the golf course's bunkers, rebuilding tee boxes and several greens, upgrading the driving range and completely replacing the irrigation system with a state of- the-art system. Butte's location right at the center of the I-15 and the I-90 interchange makes the city a gateway to the rest of


