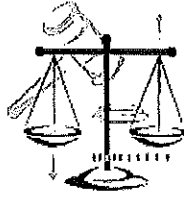

Dear Sheriff and District Attorney:

Please be advised that this office represents Kymberly Parrish in her ongoing civil No contact order against James Parrish and Jayne Holland. I am writing to formally address a highly concerning matter regarding the apparent unauthorized and nefarious use of the Harnett County Sheriff's Office FLOCK camera system by department personnel to unlawfully track, monitor, and harass my client.

Factual Background

My client and her estranged husband jointly own a farm located on Christian Light Road. Ms. Parrish has repeatedly noted that whenever she travels to the farm, Mr. Parrish inexplicably arrives at the property shortly thereafter.

Mr. Parrish is currently cohabitating with Detective Jayne Holland of the Harnett County Sheriff's Department.

Ms. Parrish is a well-respected local entrepreneur who owns two health food stores in Harnett County—one located at Campbell University and another situated directly across from

the Harnett County Courthouse. Because of these locations, her establishments are frequently patronized by local law enforcement officers.

On **July 15th, between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.**, an anonymous female called Ms. Parrish's Campbell University location and asked to speak directly with her. After Ms. Parrish moved to a quiet room to hear the caller more clearly, the anonymous individual explicitly warned my client that she had been "flocked." The caller disclosed that Kymberly's comings and goings from the Christian Light Road farm were being actively monitored using the department's FLOCK automated license plate reading system. Specifically, the caller alleged that **Detective Jayne Holland and her partner, Detective Teresa Wells**, were utilizing the system to track my client's movements. This unauthorized surveillance directly explains how Mr. Parrish has been able to repeatedly intercept my client at the farm.

Internal Affairs Involvement

Subsequent to this phone call, Ms. Parrish mentioned the incident to a visiting law enforcement officer at her store. Within an hour, Jeff Armstrong from the Sheriff's Department arrived at her business to discuss the matter. Shortly thereafter, David Register from Internal Affairs also arrived to interview my client regarding these allegations.

Given these visits, it is our understanding that an Internal Affairs investigation has already been initiated. However, the specificity and timing of these events preclude mere coincidence, and we do not believe this was a practical joke. It is highly probable that the anonymous caller is a patron of Ms. Parrish's business who felt an ethical obligation to warn her of this egregious abuse of power.

Demands and Next Steps

The use of specialized law enforcement databases to stalk, harass, or provide a tactical advantage to an estranged spouse in a civil domestic dispute is a severe violation of public trust, departmental policy, and potentially state and federal law.

Therefore, I am formally demanding the following:

1. **Immediate Preservation of Evidence:** You are hereby placed on notice to preserve any and all digital evidence, audit logs, login histories, query records, and surveillance data associated with the FLOCK camera system pertaining to Kymberly Parrish or her associated vehicles.
2. **Investigation of Proxy Logins:** We suspect that the offending detective(s) may have utilized another officer's credentials to execute these searches. We demand a full audit of the system logs around the relevant dates and times, regardless of whose specific credentials were used.
3. **Production of Records:** At the appropriate procedural juncture, my office will utilize any and all legal means necessary to subpoena the FLOCK system data and the entirety of the resulting Internal Affairs investigative file.

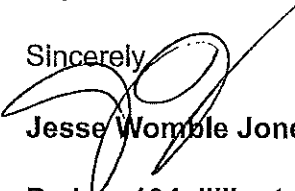
4. **Involvement of the State Bureau of Investigation (SBI):** Given the inherent conflict of interest in a department investigating its own detectives for stalking and misuse of government resources, we strongly urge you to refer this matter to the SBI for an independent and transparent review.

Finally, please find enclosed a copy of a baseless civil complaint recently filed against my client by the opposing party. You will note that the presiding judge swiftly denied this ex-parte request and set this matter for a hearing without making any emergency findings. The filing of this frivolous action further demonstrates a coordinated pattern of harassment intended to intimidate Ms. Parrish.

We expect this matter to be taken with the utmost seriousness. Law enforcement resources exist to protect the public, not to facilitate personal vendettas or domestic stalking.

I look forward to your prompt attention to this matter and anticipate confirmation that the requested evidence has been secured and preserved.
